9Methodology


A digital survey was conducted over two months in the summer of 2025, garnering 364 responses.

Less than 20% of respondents were over the age of 65, yielding a sample not statistically significant, since most Wyoming voters in the last election when lodging tax was voted on, were over the age of 65.

A hard copy survey was then created and mailed to Natrona County residents over the age of 65.




Please share which community in Natrona County you reside in.




Please indicate your current employment status


53% of respondents were retired









If you are currently employed, please indicate the industry sector that best describes your area of work.




How long have you lived in Natrona County?

raised here.









What is your age range?

50% of respondents were over the age of 65.








