No matter where you wander for a drink in Wyoming, a **Backwards Distilling Company** creation will most likely be on the menu. With an impressive line up of craft spirits made right here in Casper, Backwards' cult following is well deserved. Stop by their downtown tasting room for a locally made seasonal cocktail that is as delicious as it is Instagram-worthy.

Another happy hour hot spot is **Vintage Fine Wine & Martini Bar**. Vintage serves high-end cocktails, glasses of fine wine, local microbrews and one of the largest selections of whiskey in the area. We also strongly suggest stopping into **Urban Bottle** to not only revel in their curated selection, but to experience why locals love bellying up at this classy joint.






WHERE THE LOCALS EAT!

The rumors are true: downtown Casper is *thriving*. A gem for locals and visitors alike, downtown is where early history meets the hustle and bustle of our modern city. Walk the lively streets, window shop, grab a drink or bite to eat and take in live music. From free events in our year-round outdoor plaza to specialty crafted local cocktails and craft brews, there's something for everyone in downtown Casper.

O1 /LIVING HISTORY

Casper's earliest history took place in the streets of what is now downtown. As the city became more modern in the late 1800s, the hub of town was Center and 1st St., just as it is today. This means that a lot of life, business and history has been played out on these streets and in the historic buildings that line them. Many of the buildings you see today were built in the early 1900s. Stop by the Visitor Center and pick up a self guided walking tour map to discover the stories and history of downtown Casper up close. Pack a camera and an appetite - we promise you'll be beckoned back to explore more.



02 / DAVID STREET STATION

One of Casper's hottest attractions is **David Street Station**, where there is always something happening. This versatile gathering space hosts hundreds of events year-round including live music, festivals and farmers markets, a splash pad in the summer months and an ice rink in the winter. The cherry on top of this already-sweet venue: admission to events is always free.

03 OUR ARTISTIC SIDE

Well known for outdoor recreation and wild west history, Casper also has a surprisingly vibrant and active arts scene, and there's no better place to experience it than downtown. You'll find iconic institutions like the **Nicolaysen Art Museum** and **Art 321**, as well as countless displays of public art such as colorful murals, sculptures and more intimate galleries like **Scarlow's Art & Coffee**.

Don't miss the **Casper Art Walk** happening the first Thursday of every month May - September. Watch downtown come alive as artists and entertainment spill into the streets.

04 / INDULGE IN THE FOODIE SCENE

No matter what you're craving, you can find it downtown. With several new restaurants popping up alongside longtime staples, you won't go hungry. Fuel up on made-from-scratch cuisine at the **Yellowstone Garage**. A 1920s Studebaker dealership converted into a hip and cozy space, this bar, restaurant and music venue is now a cornerstone.

If you're in the mood for something sweet, local favorite **Frosted Tops** makes homemade macaroons, cupcakes and cinnamon roles. Don't believe us? Walk by and you can smell the goodness for yourself! If it's time for happy hour, stop by **Urban Bottle Wine & Spirits**, a hip liquor store and tasting room that often hosts live music, food pairing classes, tap takeovers and other events.

05 / LOCAL SHOPPING

Casper's downtown is home to boutique shopping worth raving about. To kick off your spree, grab a coffee (and a new read) from Wind City Books. From there, stroll on over to Floral Rhino, SHE. and The Mustard Seed for darling gifts, dazzling goods and modern aesthetics sure to make you feel right at home. While you're out, don't forget to gear up at the legendary Ugly Bug Fly Shop. Finally, take home something handcrafted from 307 Metal Works or locally made products at WyoMade. No matter your budget or taste, Casper has a little something for every shopper.



PREHISTORIC WYOMING

The area's amazing history predates humans by thousands of years. Start by discovering rich geological and prehistoric history at the **Tate Geological Museum** at Casper College. While you're there, sign up to go out in the field with the museum's paleontologists on the next dinosaur dig. You can also meet Dee - an II,600-year-old Columbian mammoth - and 3,000 of his closest fossilized friends.

WESTWARD MIGRATION

When westward expansion began in the mid1800s, Casper was a central hub for the nation's overland trails. The Oregon, California, Pony Express, Bozeman and Mormon trails all converged right here in Casper. More than half a million bold settlers made the grueling trek on these trails. Some carved their names into Independence Rock, an important historical landmark less than an hour from Casper off Highway 220. Learn about these early days of Casper at the world-class National Historic Trails Interpretive Center, Fort Caspar Museum and the Mormon Handcart Visitors Center at Martin's Cove.

THE OIL CITY

Along the way, some pioneers stayed and put down roots. What began as a cluster of shacks grew into a small town of around 1,000 residents in the late 1800s. Casper's population grew by more than 600 percent in just 20 years following the boom of oil business that began around 1910. When oil was discovered in the nearby Salt Creek Field, Casper became known as the "Oil Capital of the Rockies," a reputation that stuck. Even today, the Casper area is home to some of the nation's most productive oil fields. The Salt Creek Museum in Midwest (44 miles from Casper) chronicles the field's activity, the workers, their families and communities from 1889 to today (by appointment only).

Adventuring on, we can only hope that you find yourself immersed in the magic of what is the **Nicolaysen Art Museum**. This beautiful contemporary museum has been a cultural anchor in the community for decades. From collections from world-renowned artists and



local favorites to a Discovery Center for kids and more, this gem is a hub for art and education in the West.

If music is more your muse, meet the **Wyoming Symphony Orchestra**. Celebrating over 70 years, the Wyoming Symphony Orchestra is comprised of the region's best musicians who are dedicated to their craft. From breathtaking, year-round performances to a family-friendly summer concert in Washington Park, this organization will have you singing.

When Emerson is not loving on the many bikes of Casper down at the local outdoor shop, Mountain Sports, you can find him climbing the rock walls of Fremont Canyon or enjoying a starry night ski on Casper Mountains with loved ones. His spirit is almost as thrilling as his story.

WHY CALL CASPER HOME?

Whether it's the great outdoors or the right people to enjoy it with, there is a certain magnetism that always brings me back to Casper. From the harsh bite of winter air so cold it hurts to breathe, to getting caught in a summer squall so violent you're soaked in seconds, this place has a way of bringing you to life. Over the years I've realized that 'home' isn't just having lived somewhere. Home is friends. Home is community. And with the help of the outdoor community, I've really found my place of belonging here. This is home.



WHAT ARE YOUR FAVORITE ADVENTURES IN CASPER?

For a more adventurous day, I head out towards Fremont Canyon where a granite canyon with endless climbing awaits. With walls hundreds of feet high at times, Fremont Canyon will test your body and your mind. The exposure is breathtaking and certainly needs adjusting to, but push through the initial fear and you're met with an incredible meditative state. Focus on nothing but the task at hand and become completely present during every moment and action. This flow state can come from many different sources, but achieving this while alone on the wall makes the feeling so pure it's hard to beat. There's so much I've learned from climbing, not only valuable rope and rigging skills, but about myself.



HOW WOULD YOU LIKE TO SEE OUTDOOR REC EVOLVE HERE?

The vast amounts of public land offers a lifetime of adventure, any time of year, the options are nearly endless. We've already seen so much development focused towards outdoor recreation, both in town and surrounding areas. More people than ever are using our outdoor spaces these days, and I'm happy that we have so many good ambassadors for our community. Miles of paved and single track trails established, a beautiful new ski lodge and lights up at Hogadon, I just hope we can maintain this amazing progress.

HOW DO YOU HOPE TO SEE YOUR ART EVOLVE?

I'm hopeful that more people will want to start restoring old neon signs to their original glory! I want people to not only see neon as a tool to help their own business, but to get a message out that is important to them and say it with neon light.

The same, simple things that welcomed my ancestors home so long ago: the Platte River, Casper Mountain, wide-open-spaces and the hope for a better tomorrow.


HOW HAS CASPER HELD A SPACE FOR YOU?

There's more to Casper's rivers and lakes than just world-class fishing. At the heart of Casper is the **North Platte River**. Known for beautiful sunrises, abundant water recreation and fishing, Alcova Reservoir is one of the best places to spend a summer day. The reservoir's offerings include six campgrounds, eight boat ramps, an interpretive walking/hiking trail, a fishing pier and more. Plus, the on-site Alcova Marina offers rentals, boating supplies, a convenience store, fuel and a full restaurant and bar. For an unforgettable experience, we recommend splurging on the Resort's sunrise boat excursion through the canyon. From pristine views to natural serenity like never before, this is the Wyoming you've been waiting for.



Just down the road, you'll find **Pathfinder Reservoir**. With 117 miles of shoreline,
Pathfinder Reservoir and its expansive waters
are controlled by Pathfinder Dam. For a helping
of local history, visit the Pathfinder Interpretive
Center to learn about this engineering feat,
one that has been in place since the early 1900s.
For incredible views of the area, set out on the
1.7-mile-long interpretive trail near the dam.
Additional amenities include campsites, a
marina and restrooms. The reservoir is a great
spot for camping, boating, fishing, hiking and
birdwatching.


















Here in Casper, the wild unknown is always right at your fingertips. From the wide-open-spaces that make up the sea of the high plains to the many rivers, lakes and mountaintops just begging to be explored, it's easier than ever to get outside and go wild. Whether you're seasoned mountain folk looking for your next adventure or you're long overdue for some quality time with Mother Nature, we've got just the place to fill that void.

NO. 1 CASPER MOUNTAIN

With miles of multi-use year-round trails, you can hike, bike, Nordic ski, snowshoe or fat bike on **Casper Mountain** almost any day of the year. Popular trails include: the **Bridle Trail**, a 4.5-mile trek that starts at Rotary Park and features Casper Mountain's iconic **Split Rock** near the peak; **Eadsville Trail**, a popular mountain biking trail that offers amazing scenery; and, the **Braille Trail**, a short hiking trail that was designed for the visually impaired and includes interpretive signs, handrails and picnic areas.

In the snowy season, the Casper Mountain Nordic Trails boasts nearly 26 miles of groomed trail that ranges from flat runs to steeper inclines. One of the trails is even well-lit in the evenings. In the winter months, a trails pass is required to use the Nordic trails. Get your day-use or season pass online at natrona.net. If snowboarding or alpine skiing is your snow day activity of choice, put Hogadon Basin Ski Area at the top of your to do list. With 27 trails of varying difficulties, two lifts and a brand new lodge, Hogadon is a great way to spend a winter day. Did we mention our mountain neighbors will be offering night skiing for the first time this year? Yes, you read that right! Other notable attractions atop Casper Mountain include the Adams Memorial Archery Range, Beartrap Meadow Park, Crimson Dawn and the world-class Casper




NO. 2 EDNESS KIMBALL WILKINS STATE PARK

Just six miles outside of town, where the North Platte river meets the prairie that lies below the mountains, you'll find Edness Kimball Wilkins State park (also known as EKW) where a wildlife and picnic paradise awaits you.

The fun is endless at EKW during a Wyoming summer. The park's amenities include: 2.8 miles of paved trails, a swimming pond, beach volleyball courts, boat access to the pond, more than 40 picnic areas, river access and a playground for the kids.

Oh, it gets better. Did we mention the wildlife viewing and fishing is unmatched at EKW? Experience it for yourself.





NO. 3 FREMONT CANYON

Welcome to Wyoming's best kept secret - Fremont Canyon. Sitting about four miles Southwest of Pathfinder Dam, Fremont Canyon boasts beckoning red rock walls that rise high above the North Platter River that calmly winds and flows its way through.

Whether you dream of casting a line from the shore or traveling by kayak, this Wyoming gem is impossible to forget. Remember to keep your eyes up from time to time to admire the surrounding sandstone and limestone topography as well as a daring rock climber or two.

Pack your cameras and your western spirit - if you haven't fallen in love with Central Wyoming yet, just wait until you see this.

TRAVEL & RECREATE RESPONSIBLY.

Welcome to the Wild West. This part of Wyoming has been a place where travelers have been coming to and through for hundreds of years, and our goal is to keep it just as pristine and untouched for generations to come. When you visit Casper, we invite and encourage you to become an advocate for the outdoors and Wyoming's wild prairies.

Here are ways you can recreate responsibly and travel safely, while still soaking up all Wyoming has to offer:

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

Before you venture out into Wyoming's great outdoors, be sure you know where public land ends and private land begins. In Wyoming, any body of water that runs through private land is owned by the landowner — including the river bed. If you're fishing, be sure to know where you're floating and stay in your boat as you float through private land.

When you're out hiking or mountain biking, respect the boundary between public and private lands, as there are portions of publicly accessible trails that go through private land. Be respectful, aware and stay on the trail.

BE WELCOMING

Choose to be kind, be considerate of those around you and learn the rules of playing outside, from trail etiquette (mountain bikers yield to foot traffic; foot traffic yields to horseback riders; downhill hikers yield to hikers heading uphill) to where to camp. Here it's customary to greet other explorers with a smile and a simple "hi."

GIVE PEOPLE SPACE

In Natrona County, we have 14.5 people per square mile, which means there is lots of room to roam. When recreating outside, give others around you extra breathing room. Step off the trail and let them pass, be considerate and take advantage of Wyoming's vast spaces.



LEAVE NO TRACE

Leave the outdoors better than you found them. The biggest elements are respecting wildlife and giving them space, pack it in/pack it out (take all your garbage with you) and be sure to completely extinguish your campfire.

TREAD LIGHTLY

Stay on designated roads and trails. Park on the dirt rather than the fringe of the area where vegetation is still surviving. Go over – not around – obstacles to avoid widening trails. Cross streams at appropriate areas and avoid wet and muddy trails. When you're playing on the water, launch watercraft in designated areas and stay on waterways.

PLAN AHEAD

Weather can change quickly. Check road conditions and weather forecasts. Pack extra layers, keep water and snacks with you, and carry along hard copies of maps which can be picked up at the Visit Casper office.

Hit the Trail (or Mountain Road)

No matter the season, it's probably a good time to hit the mountain. If you're up for a hike, we recommend the **Bridle Trail** that begins at **Rotary Park** (read more on page 32). If you're more in the mood for a scenic cruise, you can meander on **Casper Mountain Road** all the way over the summit and continue on to stunning **Muddy Mountain** on the backside of Casper Mountain.

Recharge & Fuel Up

After a morning exploring, you've likely worked up an appetite. Our advice: a burger at **The Branding Iron**, where according to the *Travel Channel*, you'll find the best one in Wyoming.

Shop Local

After you've refueled and recharged, it's time to discover **downtown**. Peruse dozens of shops bursting with the creations of local makers. Highlights include **Wyoming Shirt & Gift, Lou Taubert Ranch Outfitters, Mountain Sports** and **Mustard Seed**.

Dinner & a Show

In the summer, **David Street Station**, Casper's live music and events venue, has concerts, movies, farmers markets and events several nights a week. If you're more interested in an indoor experience, several downtown venues host live music regularly. (Check VisitCasper.com/events to see what's happening.) Downtown is also home to two of Casper's iconic and historic movie theaters: the **America** and the **Rigito**.

There are a variety of quality local eateries to help you savor the flavor of Wyoming in our walkable downtown. Looking for something very Casper? Racca's Pizzeria Napoletana offers a taste of Italy with a drool-worthy menu. If your crowd is all 21+, The Gaslight Social has an extensive beer and cocktail menu with a lively environment. With an early start, you may be able to catch one of Casper's famous blazing sunrises from Lookout Point on Casper Mountain. Early risers also get a great table at one of Casper's very popular breakfast spots: **Eggington's**. Kick off the day with their phenomenal omelets, savory scrambles or their french toast that is basically a work of art. Pro tip: Don't leave without a cinnamon roll.
