



- DEE THE MAMMOTH IS NAMED AFTER
  DEE ZIMMERSHCEID, A BACKHOE OPERATOR WHO
  FOUND THE BONES IN 2006 WHEN HE WAS
  DIGGING AN OIL WELL. THE LANDOWNERS
  GENEROUSLY DONATED THE SKELETON TO THE
  TATE GEOLOGICAL MUSEUM.
- THE PLEISTOCENE BEGAN ABOUT 2.6 MILLION YEARS AGO AND LASTED UNTIL ABOUT 11,700 YEARS AGO.
- ► WOOLY MAMMOTHS WERE ROUGHLY THE SIZE OF MODERN AFRICAN ELEPHANTS WITH SHORTER EARS AND A WOOLY COAT OF FOOT LONG HAIRS AND AN UNDERCOAT OF SHORTER HAIRS.
- PRESERVED MAMMOTH HAIR LOOKS ORANGE, HOWEVER RESEARCHERS THINK THAT'S DUE TO BEING BURIED FOR SO LONG.
- SCIENTISTS CAN TELL HOW OLD A MAMMOTH IS BY THE RINGS ON THEIR TUSKS, LIKE LOOKING AT TREE RINGS. THE RINGS CAN ALSO TELL THEM THE SEASON THE ANIMAL DIED AND ITS HEALTH DURING THAT TIME.
