IV. SPEC TAX RESULTS

V. FY24 AUDIT REVIEW

Porter Muirhead Cornia & Howard, CPAs presented the FY24 audit results to the board. There were no internal control issues.

Roxy Skogen from Skogen & Cometto reminded the board that the FY24 audit was conducted strictly as cash basis. Ms. Skogen recommended to remove the "cash with fiscal agent" tax receivable amount that has historically been recorded in the monthly financial statements. This will result in the monthly financial statements agreeing to the auditing financial statement. This will also make it easier to determine compliance with the statute that requires the CVB spend at least 90% annually of the tax collections. The collections on the cash basis are known, whereas, the recording of the one month receivable was an estimated amount each year.

Ms. Gamble made a motion to approve Ms. Skogen's recommendation as presented, seconded by Mrs. Renee Penton-Jones. Motion carried without dissent.

VI. PROUD TO HOST THE BEST

The rebrand from Proud to Host the Best to "Compete Casper" has officially launched. Ms. Kraus will continue to work through the transition process.
