




CASPER, WYOMING, IS ONE OF THE BEST FISHING DESTINATIONS IN THE WORLD, AND FLY FISHING IS BY FAR THE MOST POPULAR WAY TO FISH HERE.

- EACH YEAR, THE WYOMING GAME AND FISH DEPARTMENT DESIGNATES THE FIRST SATURDAY OF NATIONAL BOATING AND FISHING WEEK A FREE FISHING DAY WHEN ANYONE CAN FISH IN WYOMING WITHOUT A FISHING LICENSE.
- THE NORTH PLATTE RIVER BOASTS ANYWHERE FROM 3,000 TO 5,000 FISH PER MILE AND IS FISHABLE ALL YEAR ROUND.
- YOU CAN CATCH ALL SORTS OF FISH IN CASPER, WYOMING, INCLUDING RAINBOW AND BROWN TROUT, CHANNEL CATFISH AND WALLEYE.
- GREY REEF, A SECTION OF THE NORTH PLATTE, IS ONE OF THE BEST SPOTS TO CATCH RAINBOW TROUT IN THE COUNTRY. THE AVERAGE WEIGHT OF A CATCH IS BETWEEN THREE AND SIX POUNDS, BUT A LUCKY FEW HAVE BEEN KNOWN TO CATCH A 20-POUNDER.
