

# CATALINA ISLAND HIKING & TRAIL INFO



Catalina Island hiking trails are open. Thank you for your patience during this pandemic.

**New hiking safety guidelines are in place for the protection of yourself and others:**

- Hiking without a face mask is permitted except if you are within 6' of a non-family member or someone with whom you are not currently quarantining; appropriate social distancing is required.
- Do not use the trails if you are exhibiting any symptoms.
- Please follow all current LA County guidelines:

- Conservancy Rangers and LA County Baywatch remain on patrol across the Island.



**Catalina Island Conservancy updates:**

- Restrooms along the trails are open.
- The Trailhead Center is open, with limited services
- Wrigley Memorial and Botanic Garden will re-open June 12.
- DC-3 Gifts & Grill at the Airport in the Sky will re-open June 17 with updated hours and menu. Inside and outside dining will be in accordance with social distancing guidelines, and masks will be required in restaurant except while eating.
- Wildlands Express will begin limited shuttle service between Avalon & Little Harbor on June 17 (No service to Two Harbors). For reservations contact: 310-510-0143.
