Bristol Mountain

Bristol Mountain - This 1200' vertical rise allows Bristol Mountain to reign as the highest vertical between the Adirondack/ Laurentian Mountains of the east and the Rocky Mountains of the west. There are 138 acres of skiable terrain, including 3KM of Nordic trails. Views of the summit and the 38 slopes and trails are breathtaking and provide a variety of inclines for every skier and snowboarder from beginner to expert. Bristol offers an array of dining options while skiing. Two base lodges, a cafeteria style eatery, summit grilling and a slope-side waffle house. Services include rental equipment, a full snow sports retail store, and equipment Tuning center.



History: Bristol Mountain was established in 1964 after the land was bought in South Bristol NY by Fred Sarkis. 50 of the 360 acres was cleared and the base lodge was built. Snow making capabilities and a new lift was added in 1965. By the 1970's, Bristol was getting over 100,000 skiers per year and open 7 days per week. They progressively made snow making improvements and by 1985 they had 100% coverage and guaranteed over 100 days of skiing per season. In 1999 the first modern chairlift was added, and in 2009/2010 the new high speed detachable chairlift was added.

In the summer of 2014 Bristol Mountain Aerial Adventures was introduced. It is a 3 acre aerial park consisting of 7 challenging courses with nearly 100 tree to tree elements and 10 zip lines. Bristol also has cross country skiing available at the Summit Nordic Center, consisting of two trails, one of which has snow making and lights for night skiing. The Summit Nordic Center is not directly accessible from Bristol's downhill base lodges; visitors must use the separate entrance by driving up the mountain to South Hill Road off of County Road 32.
