


Cayuga County has 8 lakes and the Erie Canal.




Aurora was once known as "Peachtown" because it had over 1000 peach trees.





The Underground Railroad "Conductor", Harriet Tubman lived in Auburn.






Little Sodus Bay is the Brown Trout capital of the world.










Fillmore Glen State Park has 5 waterfalls.
