BRAVE WOMEN

Trailblazers like Harriet Tubman, Emily Howland, and Frances Seward carved out a new future for all of us in this fiercely beautiful region. As the epicenter of the Women's Rights Movement over 100 years ago, the Finger Lakes region celebrates women both past and present. 2020 marks the centennial of the 19th Amendment, which gave women the right to vote. Pay homage to the bold, courageous women who not only made their homes in the Finger Lakes, but also made history here by supporting the women of today who run hotels, manage restaurants, own shops, maintain trails and do everything in between.

HISTORICAL STOPS

Pay a visit to the Harriet Tubman National Historical Park, the site of the equal rights activist and emancipator's home where she lived for her later 50 years! Tour the Seward House Museum to learn how William Henry Seward's wife, Frances



was the strength and inspiration for the abolition and Underground Railroad movements in the household. Next door stop by the New York State Equal Rights Heritage Center, a digitally interactive space celebrating the state's history of movements in civil. women's and LGBTQ+ rights.



Travel south to Sherwood, listed on The National Register of Historic Places as the Equal Rights Historic District. Several of the properties within the district were owned by freed slaves; others by prominent abolitionists and women's rights advocates who sprang from the Quaker faith. Find original women's suffrage posters at the Opendore Project Museum; housed in a portion of the Isabel Howland House. Then, visit the unique Howland Stone Store Museum and find among their cabinet of curiosities a piece of Susan B. Anthony's 78th birthday cake (1898).

WOMEN TRAIL BLAZERS

Harriet Tubman, the Moses of her people and a conductor on the Underground Railroad, settled and remained in Auburn for the latter part of her life. Here she created the Home for the Aged, now part of the Harriet Tubman National Historical Park. Visit Tubman's grave and leave a personal memento at the historic Fort Hill Cemetery in Auburn.


Sisters Georgiana and Caroline Willard commissioned the Tiffany Glass and Decorating Company of NYC to design and handcraft the entire interior of the Willard Memorial Chapel, showcasing their stunning work in stained glass and mosaic tiling. It is the only complete and unaltered totally Tiffany- designed religious interior known to exist in the world. There are also two other Tiffany windows on view in Auburn in the west wing of the Cayuga Museum, where the Willards lived, and behind the alter in the Westminster Presbyterian Church.

On July 13, 1848, Auburnians Lucretia Mott and Martha Coffin Wright attended the first Women's Rights Convention in the United States.



Live music, theater, dance, fine arts, film and history make up our rich culture and lifestyle. From the Tiffany windows at Willard Memorial Chapel to live performances at Auburn Public Theater and The Rev Theatre Co., art and culture come alive in Cayuga County!

THE ARTS: INSIDE & OUT

Like color and pattern? Come tour Downtown Auburn's Public Art Trail featuring over a dozen signature mosaics, metal sculptures and painted murals created by local artists and volunteers. For fine art lovers, the Schweinfurth Art Center offers contemporary exhibits in the gallery. For textile artists and quilters, don't miss their annual international juried Quilts=Art=Quilts exhibit. Visit the newly-opened Blake Chamberlain Studio & Gallery, renowned for his patchwork kaleidoscope human rights activist portraits, and browse cutting edge paintings, graphic prints and apparel.

Spend the day exploring Wells College, located in the quaint village of Aurora. This liberal arts college offers a variety of events and self-guided tours. Explore the historic campus and enjoy art exhibits, special programs, guest lectures and more. Fair Haven is a hidden gem for our artistic visitors, with South Shore Artisans, Fair



Haven Arts Center and the Hardware Café's unique gift shop, where you will encounter a plentitude of local artisans' work.









PERFORMING ARTS

Cayuga County is the entertainment hub of the Finger Lakes. Whether it's theater, dance, live performances or music you love, you'll find it all here. At Auburn Public Theater, the artistic flagship of downtown Auburn, you can enjoy plays, national touring comedy acts, dance productions, community events, film and live music. On Owasco Lake, the Rev Theatre Co. brings not to be missed professional musicals and theatrical performances held at the Merry-Go-Round Playhouse. Known as "Broadway in the Finger Lakes," the playhouse, located in a historic carousel building in picturesque Emerson Park, is upstate New York's most popular professional theatre performing favorite Broadway musicals from May – October.

In Aurora, theater and literary arts programs are presented at the intimate Morgan Opera House, a restored Victorian gem featuring leaded glass windows, splendid woodwork and superb acoustics. Near Lake Ontario, the Elizabethan Sterling Renaissance Festival is set in a shady forest offering more than 100 live shows daily, plus jousting, family games and rides, fine arts and crafts demonstrations in their marketplace, and themed food and beverage vending.

VENUES



Auburn Public Theater's Founder Angela Daddabbo came back to the fold after living in LA bringing connections galore, so audiences now watch national comedy acts and musical performances for under \$20 a ticket. APT hosts women's performances, workshops and entertainment during Women's History Month in March. The theatre is credited for kick starting the revitalization of Auburn's

diverse cultural arts scene.

DRINK LOCAL WINE

Make fond memories while visiting Cayuga County's eleven wineries. Meet the producers that create some of the best wines in NYS, while touring their charming establishments and sampling the fruits of their labor. Wine tasting in Cayuga County is a special experience in an intimate atmosphere that focuses on the highest quality craftsmanship.

GORGEOUS VIEWS

On the eastern side of Cayuga Lake, admire the views and fall in love with the wines, with five wineries within 20 minutes apart, offering unique tasting rooms and experiences. From Long Point Winery, offering award winning Red Zinfandel, Syrah, and Dry Riesling, to Bright Leaf Winery's 2021 medal winning Cab Franc, and our newest, Quarry Ridge Winery's fan favorite Dry Rose. From any location you will delight in the refreshing, summer lake breezes throughout the growing season.

Visit Heart & Hands Wine Company, a small, artisanal winery where husband and wife team, Tom & Susan Higgins, focus exclusively on Pinot Noir, sparkling wine, and Riesling. This boutique winery produces 2,000 cases per year, allowing for an intense focus on quality. Enjoy guided, informative tastings in their cozy tasting room. For another special wine tasting experience, opt for Izzo's White Barn Winery, a small boutique farm winery known for being a wedding venue with a personal touch.

LOCATION, LOCATION

Up north, Colloca Estate Winery is set on the shores of Lake Ontario with 900' of unobstructed waterfront, and 11 acres planted for Riesling, Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Colloca was awarded 2019 New York Riesling Winery and the 2020 NYS Pinot Noir Winery. In addition to wine tasting, the property is a premiere venue for weddings and hosts their own events all year round.



DRINK LOCAL CRAFT BEER

Within the past few years, our craft, nano- and microbreweries have exploded. From just coming online to relocating and expanding their footprints, Cayuga County has six successful breweries offering everything from sours, IPAs, porters, ales, and more. Come enjoy our pints, flights, and growlers in northern, central, and southern Cayuga County.

AWARD WINNERS

With one new brewery and three major expansions, the craft beer offerings keep getting better. Prison City Pub & Brewery opened their big new brewhouse and taproom on North Street in Auburn. With honors including the 2020 Best IPA Beer in NYS and 2020 Gold for "Elegant Pride" you will find picking your favorite a challenge.

Lunkenheimer Craft Brewing Co. in Weedsport took home the most awards in the 2020 New York State Brewers Association Craft Beer competition. Sample their award winning 'Exit 40' and wood fired pizza after you take Exit 40 off the NYS Thruway to enjoy their new location in Weedsport, NY.

Aurora Brewing Co. has completed tasting room upgrades and grown in popularity. Imbibe in the great outdoors from their tasting room while viewing the rolling farmland leading down to Cayuga Lake.

To the south, Summerhill Brewing in Locke hosts live music, game night, and happy hour yoga, plus pours handcrafted small batch ales, ambers, IPAs, porters, and tans. For weekend eats, choose from comfort food or Sunday Brunch prepared by partner business, Little Yard Farms.

THRIVING DOWNTOWN SCENE

Auburn's Next Chapter Brewpub offers chocolate milk and peanut butter mole stouts, wood fired pizzas and small plates. Enjoy their lovely outdoor patio for al fresco dining on Exchange Street. A block away, Shep's Brewing Company pours twelve varieties of ales, IPAs, and lagers catering to every preference. Across the street, try Thirsty Pug Craft Beer Market for world-class craft brew tap selections that no one else is pouring anywhere nearby. Choose from Plan Bee, Evil Twin, Firestone... you get the idea. On the way out, browse their impressive take-away retail display and watch for their special release events.



HOW'S THEM APPLES?

For a hands-on outdoor experience, The Apple Station is the perfect place to u-pick and buy apples. Inside, they feature their apple, grape and blended fruit wines as well as some of the best apple cider donuts you've ever tasted. For hard cider, try Grisamore Cider Works, which sprung from a family run apple orchard started in the 1970s. Back up north, Sterling Cidery features craft ciders made with 100% local apples. They transform their fresh juice into delicious hard cider, with oaken, hopped, standard and cassis ciders available.

ONE STOP SHOP



Adventure types, seize the day with an abundance of outdoor recreational activities including hiking, biking, fishing, boating, swimming, camping and even scuba diving! With three state parks, well-groomed trails, nature preserves and three state forests, the opportunities are many to get out and enjoy the great outdoors.

STATE PARKS

Up north, Fair Haven Beach State Park offers 823 acres on Lake Ontario, with one of the finest public lakefronts in the state. Come explore this diverse landscape ranging from towering shoreline bluffs to 1500' of beautiful sand, beach to hilly woodlands.

To the south on 941 acres, Fillmore Glen State Park is an oasis of cool, dense woods hugging a long, narrow gorge. Its hiking trails offer spectacular views of unique geological formations, five waterfalls and a botanically rich glen. Minutes from wineries, a brewery, Wells College, shops, five star restaurants and historic lodging you will find Long Point State Park. Easy access to the Cayuga Lake shore makes this park a popular spot for paddle-sports enthusiasts and fishermen alike.

PREMIER LAKE PARKS AND HISTORIC BIKE TRAILS

Don't miss out on all the activities available at Emerson Park at the northern point of Owasco Lake, featuring boat launches and slips, a disc golf course, playground, paddle craft rentals and picnic shelters; it is also home to the Merry Go Round Playhouse and multiple summer events.

To the southeast, Bear Swamp State Forest features 14 miles of multiple-use marked trails designed for family-friendly cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, hiking, horseback riding and mountain biking. Next stop nearby, Bahar Nature Preserve on Skaneateles Lake treats hikers to dramatic views of a 100' deep creek ravine and Carpenter Falls. The trail also includes a 65' crescent of lakeshore, ideal to beach a canoe or kayak before hiking up the ridge trail.

For a historic bike trail, head to the Cayuga County Erie Canal Recreational Trail that runs along a canal tow path manicured for hikers, bicyclists, horseback riders and, in winter, snowmobilers. High points include the magnificent Richmond Aqueduct, the second largest on the Erie Canal.



The Cayuga Lake Scenic Byway was designated back in 2002 and is an 87-mile loop on the boarders of, you guessed it, Cayuga

Lake. Some great opportunities to shop and sip lay along this route. You can enjoy not only the beautiful views, make sure you stop in the Charming villages of Aurora and Union Springs!

The Owasco Lake scenic route is always beautiful, but especially so for taking the fall foliage. While Owasco Lake is the smallest of the Finger Lakes it has tremendous features that provide access to two parks, Emerson Park in Auburn and Fillmore Glen State Park in Moravia. Along Route 90 you'll find the Montezuma National Wildlife Refuge and Montezuma winery, as well as Auburn that is chockfull of history, museums and a vibrant downtown district.







for the **BIRDS**

Cayuga County is home to 350+ "Life List" birds in the flyways and skyways from north to south and east to west. You may encounter a 3" hummingbird, a 4' tall Great Blue Heron or a tom turkey strutting his stuff for his harem of hens.

Since 1938, the Montezuma National Wildlife Refuge has provided resting, feeding, breeding and nesting habitat for wildlife, waterfowl and migratory birds. Montezuma is situated in the midst of one of the most active flight lanes in the Atlantic Flyway. For a more secluded birding option, explore Dorothy McIlroy Bird Sanctuary, featuring some of the highest breeding bird diversity in the state.

Discovery, inspiration, learning and tranquility await you at Sterling Nature Center. This spectacular 1400-acre site, with two miles of Great Lake shoreline, features glacially formed bluffs with scenic vistas of Lake Ontario. Enjoy nature at its finest by venturing through a flood plain forest on the southern Owasco Lake Inlet. Owasco Flats wetland of large fern and willow marsh supports a large variety of plants and animals unique to the area, including two-dozen species of rare birds. Come here for bird watching, photography, serene fishing and paddle-craft fun.
