Established in 1852, this burial ground has a unique history stretching beyond that initial dedication, as the site is believed to have been used as a fortified hill fort by a local Native American tribe in the mid-16th century. Today, Fort Hill Cemetery is both a historic site and an active cemetery. Take a stroll through history and visit the final resting place of three of our Brave Women Trailblazers of the Finger Lakes: Har- riet Tubman, Frances Seward and Martha Coffin Wright.
