Matilda Joslyn Gage

Matilda Joslyn Gage was a 19th Century women's suffragist, a Native American rights activist, an abolitionist, a free thinker and a prolific author. One of the most radical, far-sighted and articulate early feminists, Matilda was deliberately written out of history after her death in 1898 by an increasingly conservative suffrage movement. She is the eponym for the Matilda effect, which describes the tendency to deny women credit for scientific invention. Matilda's views on suffrage and feminism were considered too radical by many members of the suffrage association, and in consequence, she organized the Women's National Liberal Union in 1890.
