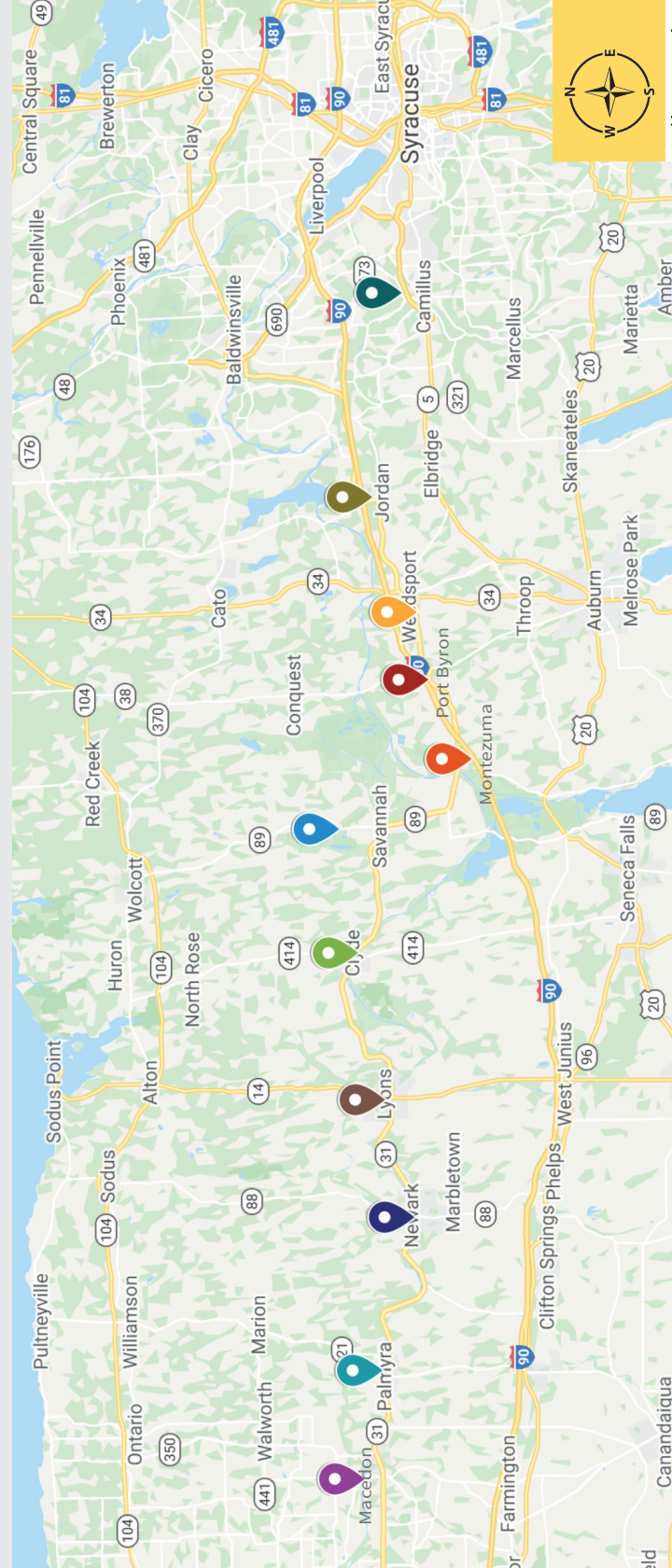


Montezuma Heritage Park and Trails
