About **CEDAR PARK**



Cedar Park wasn't always the bustling community that it is today. The city's rich history started with only a handful of courageous, yet determined, settlers.

They endured countless hardships and challenges to build the city we know today. Though times have changed, that pioneering spirit remains a foundational piece of our city's culture.

Cedar Park History



1870s: George W. Cluck arrived in 1873, purchasing 329 acres of Texas Hill Country and built a homestead on Running Brushy Creek. Limestone Rock Quarry was founded on the property and became the major employer in the late 1800s.



1880s: Narrow Gauge Railroad was the first railroad to tap the mineral-rich heart of the Hill Country. The company laid railroad tracks from Austin to Burnet. Running Brushy changed its name to Brueggerhoff in 1883, but was soon renamed Cedar Park by Emmett Cluck.



Early 1900s: Cedar yards were established to produce fence posts from the many cedar trees in the region. These cedar fence posts were in high demand throughout Texas. Many workers supported their families by cutting cedar posts.



1920s–1930s: The 3,000 sq. ft. Whitestone School first opened its doors to the children of Cedar Park. The railroad company built a spur from the mainline to the Limestone Rock Quarry.

FUN FACT: In 1871, George Cluck, founder of Cedar Park, made a cattle drive up the Chisolm Trail with his wife, Harriet. She was the first woman ever to ride the Chisolm Trail.

MORE: Cedar Park History



1940s–1950s: Faubion Grocery was built on old Highway 183. It became the second post office/grocery and served as the primary post office until 1979. In 1943, the state dairy and hog farm was created.



1960s–1970s: Hog farm residents dammed Buttercup Creek to form Twin Lakes and a park. In 1972, the Cedar Park Volunteer Fire Department was established. Residents voted to incorporate the City of Cedar Park on February 24, 1973.



1980s: In 1982, the discovery of one of the most complete and earliest examples of a human skeleton in North America was discovered at the Wilson-Leonard Brushy Creek Burial Site. It was estimated to be between 8,000–10,000 years old.

1990s: On July 25, 1992, the Austin Steam Train Association debuted the first Hill Country Flyer train ride.



2000s: Lakeline Boulevard, the 183A Toll road, 1890 Ranch shopping center, and Cedar Park Regional Medical Center opened. In 2009 the Cedar Park Center (now H-E-B Center at Cedar Park) officially opened with George Strait as the featured performer.

2012–Present: City Offices relocated to the City Hall Complex at 450 Cypress Creek Road. Bell Boulevard Redevelopment Master Plan was created.

Our incredible parks are popular with locals and visitors alike. Stay for more of the outdoors and explore the lush green lawns and trails throughout Cedar Park.



Brushy Creek Lake Park: A 90-acre park that includes a playground, water playscape, hike and bike trail, nature trail, exercise station, three pavilions, picnic tables with BBQ grills, sand volleyball courts, canoe/kayak launch, fishing pier, wildlife observation area, labyrinth, restrooms, parking area, and a 38-acre man-made lake.

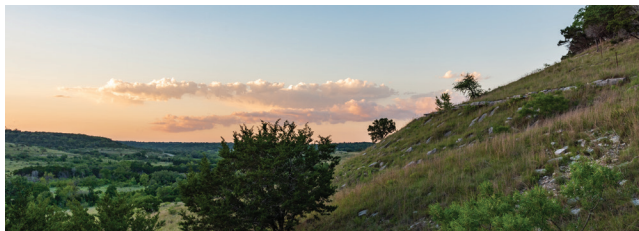
Balcones Canyonlands National Wildlife Refuge

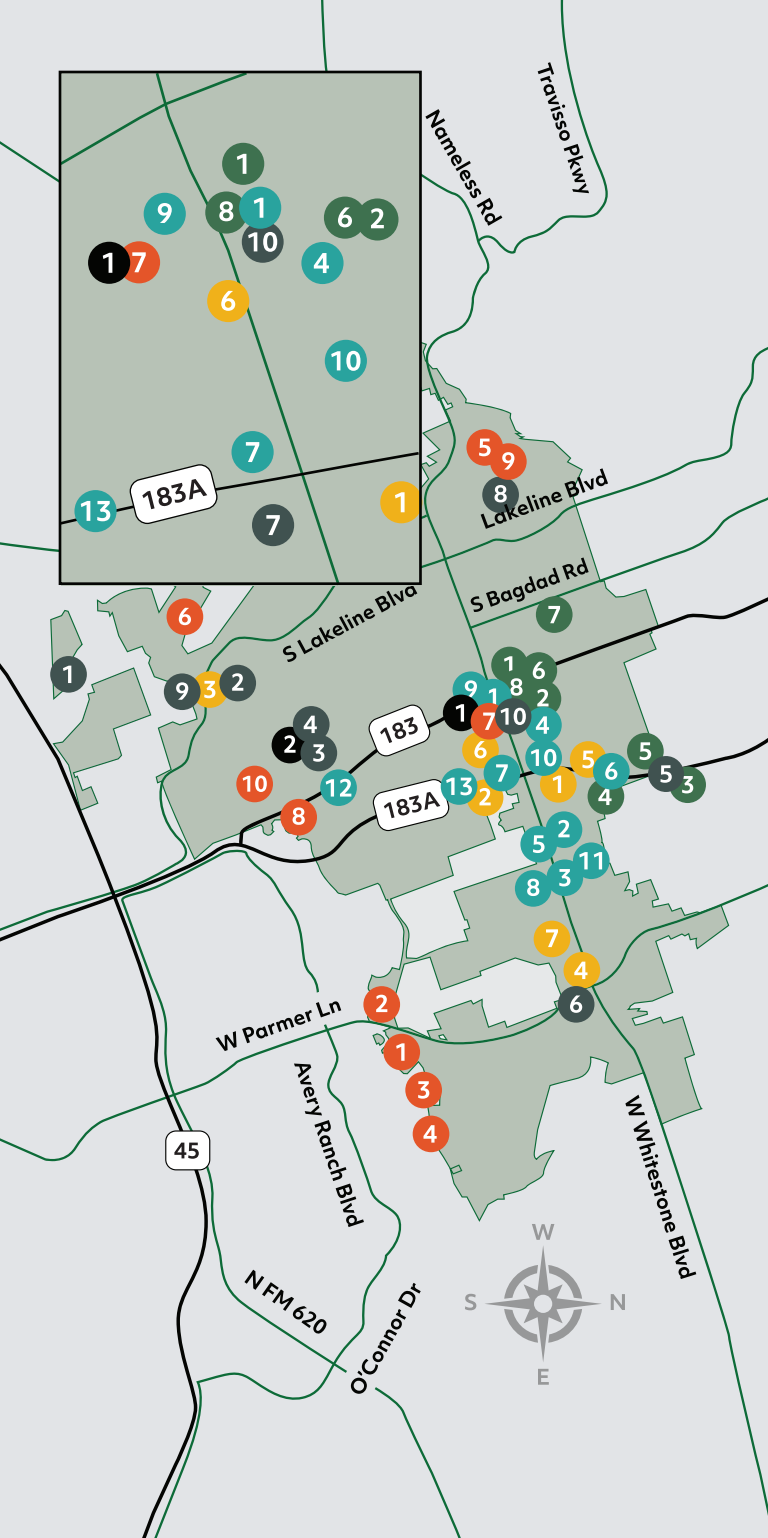
