University Place Updates – Regan Thomas Ram Realty

Presentation

- Retail spaces being redeveloped to face externally. There will be a mix of local, regional, and national businesses, including shopping, restaurant, and entertainment. Will include 8 retail spaces for small businesses getting started in a brick and mortar location (called Upstart).
 - o Retail rents are on track with Blue Hill and are average for the market. UP is willing to work with businesses to be more affordable.
- Residential Infill with 900 Willow, with 10% of units designated as affordable housing
- Common space for community events, with art being commissioned for mural space on parking deck, and other spaces.

Questions:

- o How comparable are retail rents? Retail rents are on track with Blue Hill and are average for the market. UP is willing to work with businesses to be more affordable.
- o Rental values for the 900 willow and how does it compare to rents on Franklin Street?
- o Forecast on jobs and retail sales tax?
