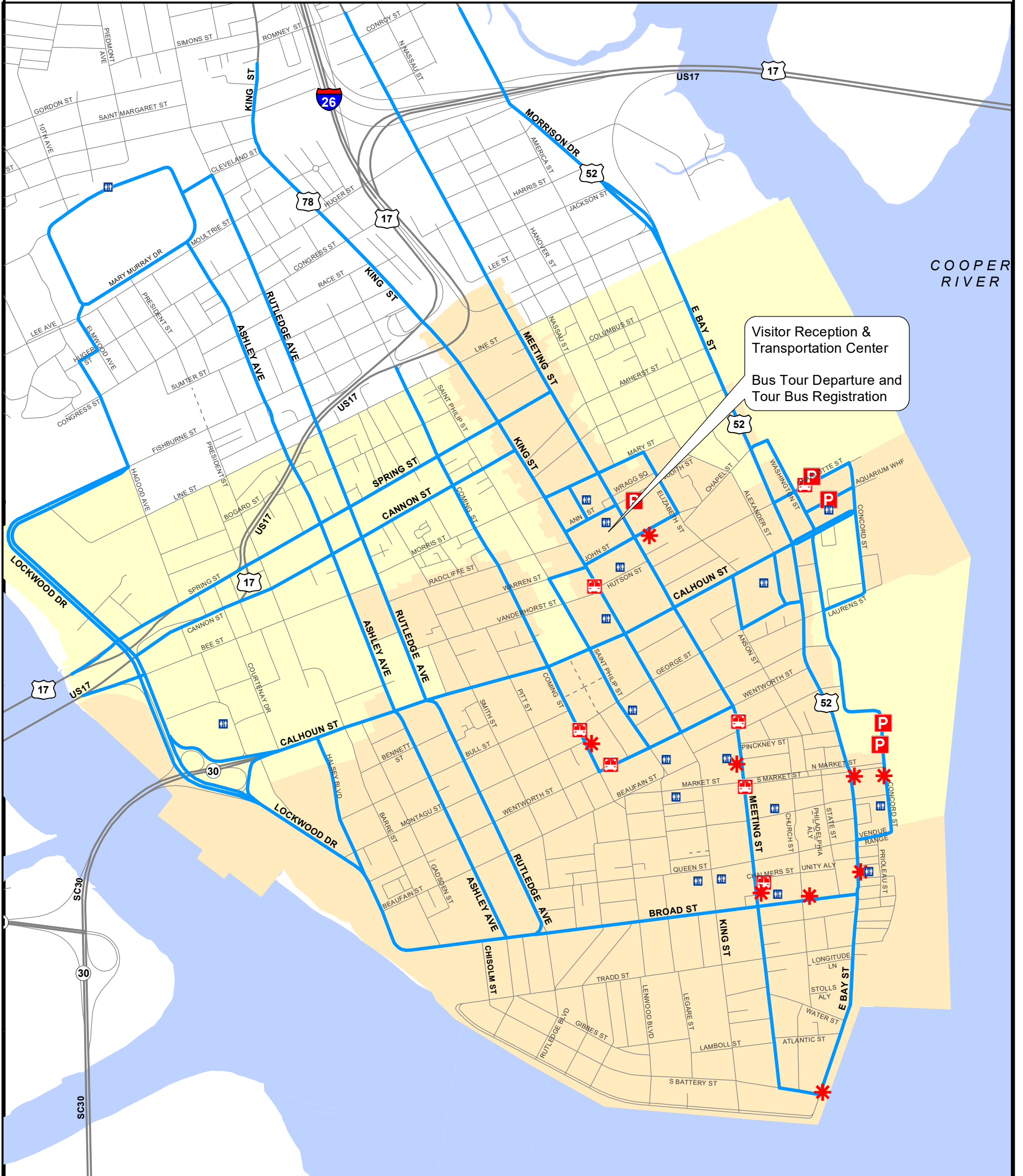

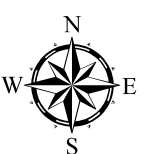

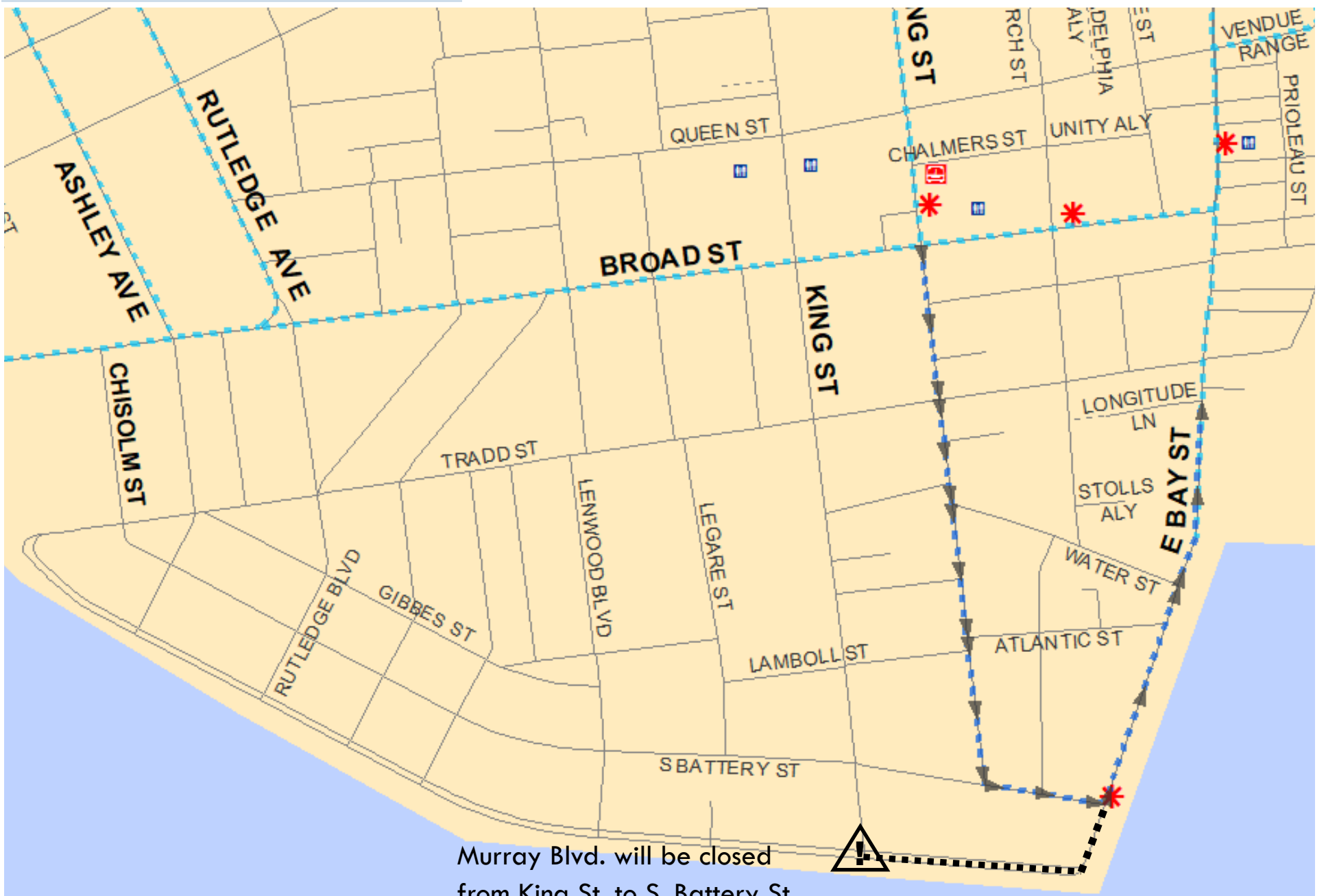

The next phase of work on the low battery wall along Murray Boulevard and E. Battery Street will begin in early February. This work will alter the perimeter bus route eliminating access along Murray Boulevard on both East and West Bound lanes around White Point Garden during this work.

Please review the route changes below, which have buses traveling south on Meeting Street to South Battery and then east on South Battery to E. Battery. Additionally, the loading zone at White Point Garden will be relocated to the north bound lane of E. Battery Street during this phase of construction.



Murray Blvd. will be closed from King St. to S. Battery St.
