Peace River Wildlife Center (PRWC) non-profit wildlife rehabilitation and education center tucked neatly into the mangroves overlooking Charlotte Harbor at Ponce de Leon Park in Punta Gorda Isles, Florida.

The Center and gift shop are open to the public for tours every day from 11 am to 4 pm. There is no admission fee, but donations are greatly appreciated.

Most trails are handicap accessible and wheelchairs are available to checkout. Shop for unique, locally made treasures in the gift shop, feed the koi in the expansive water-lily-filled pond, witness the beauty of pollinators in the Butterfly House, see unique birds, and witness what's in bloom as you stroll throughout the sanctuary. Discover sea stars, live shells, hermit crabs, and larger mammals, such as dolphins and manatees. These environmentally conscious trips allow you to see wildlife while learning about the importance of preservation and conservation. SUP Englewood's paddling services include paddleboard and kayak rentals (including multiple-day rentals), kayak and SUP Guided Eco Tours, and paddleboard lessons.

The pavilions are available to rent for birthday parties, family reunions, corporate parties, large picnics, and other special events.

Beach wheelchairs are available free of charge on a help-yourself basis, daily from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm. Note: chairs must be returned by 3:30 pm to be locked up for the night.

Parking is .75¢ per hour, payable via the Park Mobile app or with a Charlotte County Parking Pass.
