Our Visitor Centers are now mobile & operate Wednesday – Sunday at set locations in Charlottesville & Albemarle County.

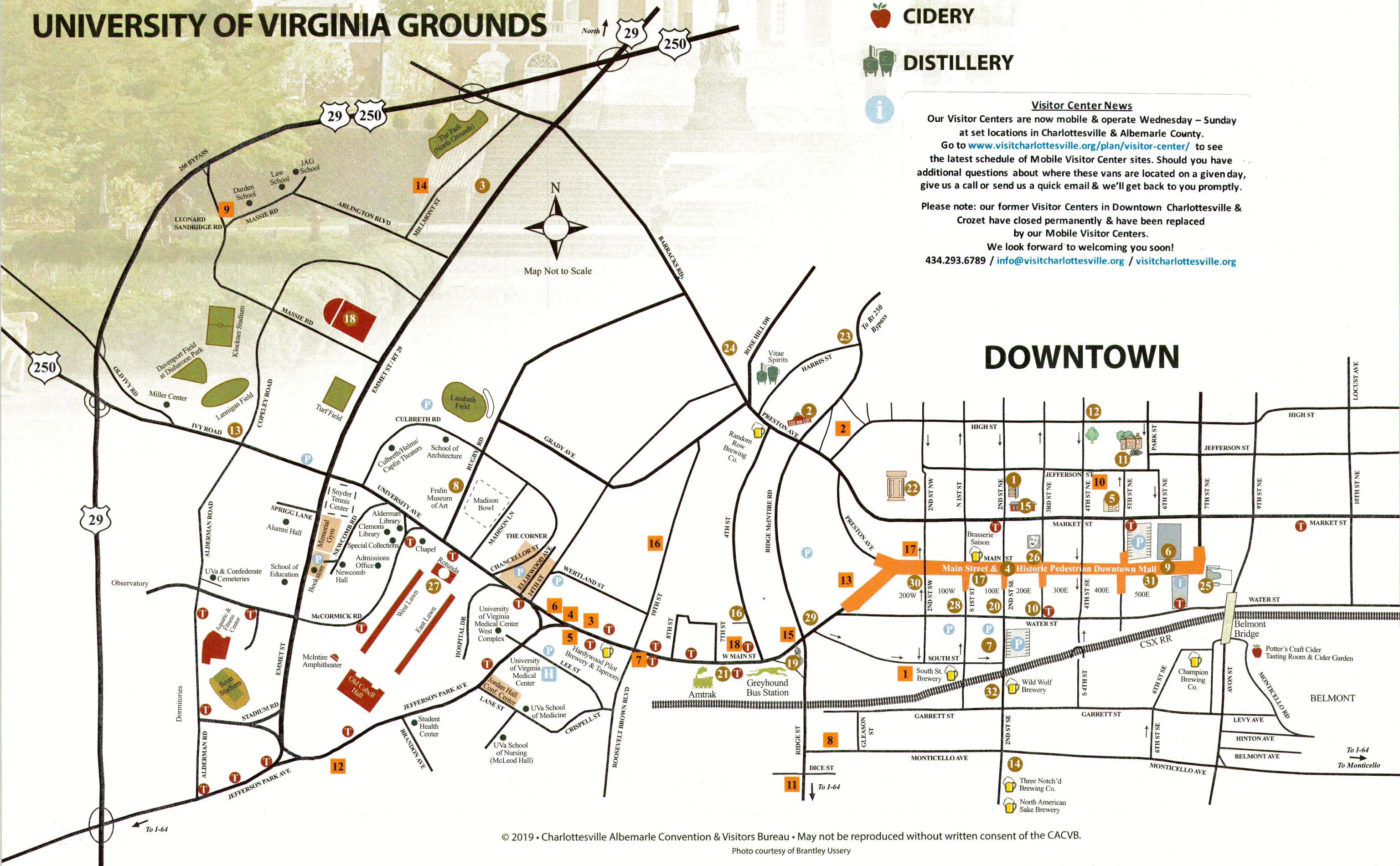
