


**APPENDIX: DEI Data Deep Dive** February 2023





#### Diversity, Equity, Inclusion (DEI) Measures

The Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion section of the Census measured sentiment on 6 different adjective pairs that represent the opposite ends of a sentiment range. For example, the first adjective pair below is "Racist/Inclusive" and respondents could choose: very [racist], somewhat [racist], somewhat [inclusive], or very [inclusive], and in the data below, you will see that 74% identified the Chattanooga music ecosystem as "inclusive" (aggregating somewhat and very inclusive) and 26% identified it as racist (aggregating somewhat and very racist).










