WELCOME TO CHELTENHAM

The first National Hunt Festival was staged at Cheltenham in 1911 as a two-day meeting, created specifically to showcase the very best of steeplechasing and hurdling. Racing at Cheltenham had drawn huge crowds for years, even when the course was situated high on the impressive Cleeve Hill above today's venue.

Route options:

Honeybourne Line 2.1 miles, 45 minute walk. Please note there are no pubs along this route until you reach the Prince of Wales Stadium & Sports Bar.

Honeybourne Line & Town Centre 2.4 miles, 54 minute walk. Turn off at New Street.

Montpellier & Town Centre 2.6 miles, 1 hour. Mostly flat walk passing lots of pubs & cafés.
