


STARTING Tail GATE

RESERVED PARKING: (PRICED PER CAR)

For the full experience, go tailgate. This will allow you to pull your vehicle onto the grass adjacent to the race course for the best view. Tailgaters usually come prepped with folding chairs and tables, tablecloths, and a full spread.

GENERAL ADMISSION:

General admission tickets require you to park in a lot and then walk to the course, where you can take in the racing from spectator areas. Bring picnic or purchase food and drink onsite.
