## Museum Highlight: Cowgirls of the West Museum & Emporium

Located in the heart of downtown Cheyenne, the Cowgirls of the West Museum & Emporium celebrates the often-overlooked women who helped shape the American West. Founded by a group of local women determined to preserve these stories, the nonprofit museum brings cowgirl history to life through authentic artifacts, photographs, and personal accounts spanning ranch life, early homesteading, and the daring rodeo era. Visitors can explore exhibits that highlight the grit, resilience, and independence of Wyoming women, offering a deeper, more complete picture of Western heritage.

Just next door, the Emporium extends the experience with a charming collection of Western goods, from locally made items and jewelry to books, art, and collectibles. Proceeds from the shop directly support the museum, which remains free to the public and operated by passionate volunteers dedicated to sharing these stories. Small in size but rich in meaning, this unique stop offers an authentic glimpse into the spirit of the West—and the women who helped define it.
