## Free attractions in the Cincy Region

### Cincinnati, Ohio

\***Cincinnati Art Museum:** Offering free general admission, this museum in Eden Park showcases over 67,000 works spanning 6,000 years of history.

\***Cincinnati Black Music Walk of Fame:** An interactive attraction that utilizes AI technology to create an immersive experience. Visitors can sing along with some of Cincinnati's music icons!

\***Cincinnati Music Hall:** Explore the stunning architecture of this historic building for free during regular operating hours. Tickets are required for performances.

\***Contemporary Arts Center:** Enjoy free admission to rotating contemporary art exhibitions in downtown Cincinnati.

\***Findlay Market:** Ohio's oldest continuously operated public market offers a vibrant atmosphere, diverse food vendors, and local artisanal products to explore.

\***Smale Riverfront Park:** Situated along the Ohio River, this park features interactive fountains, swings, walking paths, and beautiful views of the skyline.

\***Spring Grove Cemetery and Arboretum:** Explore one of the largest nonprofit cemeteries in the United States, known for its scenic landscapes, historic monuments, and arboretum.

\***Washington Park:** Located in Over-the-Rhine, this urban park hosts free events, concerts, and activities throughout the year, including a popular summer concert series.

## Free attractions in the Cincy Region

### Northern Kentucky

- \***Big Bone Lick State Historic Park:** Big Bone Lick is considered one of the most important paleontological sites in North America. The site contains the remains of ancient mammals, including mammoths, mastodons, and other Ice Age creatures. Beautiful walking trails take you around the park and along the way, make sure to view the live Bison!
- \***Devou Park:** Offering panoramic views of Cincinnati and the Ohio River, this park features hiking trails, picnic areas, and a golf course.
- \***Licking Riverside Historic District:** View stunning historic homes, learn about how this area aided in assisting slaves escape across the Ohio River to freedom with the markers throughout the riverfront. Don't forget to check out the stunning view of the iconic **Roebing Suspension Bridge** which served as a prototype for the Brooklyn Bridge.
- \***MainStrasse Village:** Explore this charming historic district in Covington, featuring cobblestone streets, unique shops, restaurants, and frequent festivals.
- \***Newport on the Levee:** Experience breathtaking views of the Cincinnati Skyline. The Levee hosts visitor focused events all year long. Grab a bite to eat or a drink while taking in the views and you may even see **B&B Riverboats** passing by!
- \***Rabbit Hash General Store:** Take a scenic drive to the small river town of Rabbit Hash! Find unique gifts made from the locals, take a stroll through town, and maybe even spot the town's Mayor, a French Bulldog named Wilbur.
- \***Roebing Murals:** A detailed description of the history of Covington, KY illustrated in a stunning mural display along the riverfront at **Covington Landing**.
