Two new special exhibits coming to National Underground Railroad Freedom Center

This state-of-the-art museum is committed to honoring and exploring freedom's heroes. The National Underground Railroad Freedom Center will be opening two new temporary exhibits in 2023 that you do not want to miss.

- *'Free as they want to be': Artists Committed to Memory;* this moving exhibit explores the historic role that photography and film have played in remembering slavery and its aftermath. Featuring more than 20 artists, this exhibit uses photography, video, silkscreen, projection and mixed media. Open through March 6, 2023.
- Solidarity Now! 1968 Poor People's Campaign; take a deep dive into one of the most important grassroots movements of the civil rights era. This exhibit uses photographs, objects, documentaries and maps to tell the story of one of the earliest fights for equality in the United States. Open from March 18 June 11, 2023.

Girlhood exhibit from Smithsonian coming to Cincinnati Museum Center
