STOPS

- 1** **Huber's Orchard, Winery, & Vineyards / Starlight Distillery**
Private wine/spirits tasting, catered lunch on the patio with live music and U-pick wagon ride to pick pumpkins and other seasonal produce.
- 2** **Maker 13**
Get hands on at Maker 13. Personalize and etch their choice of rock glasses or wine goblets to take home.
- 3** **Jack O' Lantern Spectacular**
Walk among 5,000 professionally carved pumpkins illuminated along a 1/3-mile trail. Held in Iroquois Park in Louisville.
- 4** **Clue Party at the Culbertson Mansion State Historic Site**
Dress up as your favorite character, enjoy cocktails and search the mansion's 25 rooms for clues. Private group rentals are also available.
- 5** **Visit an Old-World Style Pub in New Albany at Pints&union**
Satisfy your Old-World cravings with tastings and menu options at SoIN's most unique pub.

Itinerary 2: Hoosier History Tour

STOPS

- 1** **The Carnegie Center for Art and History**
Hear the story of the courageous acts of the Underground Railroad in two exhibits. Groups can also participate in a make-and-take experience based upon the exhibits.
- 2** **The Second Baptist's "Town Clock Church"**
Constructed in 1852, this historical building is connected to the regional network of Underground Railroads. Group tours are available by appointment.
- 3** **The Falls of the Ohio State Park and Interpretive Center**
Groups can see the world's largest exposed Devonian fossil beds when river levels are low. The Interpretive Center takes groups on an interactive timeline of the people, places and animals from 390 million years ago to today. **The site was recently added to the Lewis and Clark National Historic Trail.**
- 4** **The Howard Steamboat Museum**
Step into the Steamboat Era at the Howard Steamboat Museum. This beautiful 1894 mansion is open year-round, it offers both guided and self-guided tours.

STOPS

- 1** **Derby Dinner Playhouse: Annual Christmas Performance**
The only dinner theatre in the Kentuckiana region, featuring a delicious buffet and Broadway musicals.
- 2** **Louisville Mega Cavern: Lights Under Louisville**
This underground wonder turns into a holiday light spectacular. Enjoy a 30-minute ride through 17 miles.
- 3** **Charlestown, Indiana "Christmas City"**
Groups will enjoy a spectacular animated light show set to music on the city square, a 50' Christmas Tree and lights on every corner.
- 4** **Churchill Downs / Kentucky Derby Museum & Reindeer Games**
Package includes all elements of "Off To The Races" with a holiday twist, a mock racing event that teaches participants the tips and tricks of waging.
