Itinerary 2: Hoosier History Tour

STOPS

The Carnegie Center for Art and History
Hear the story of the courageous acts of the Underground
Railroad in two exhibits. Groups can also participate in a
make-and-take experience based upon the exhibits.

The Second Baptist's "Town Clock Church"
Constructed in 1852, this historical building is connected to the regional network of Underground Railroads. Group tours are available by appointment.

The Falls of the Ohio State Park and Interpretive Center

Groups can see the world's largest exposed Devonian fossil beds when river levels are low. The Interpretive Center takes groups on an interactive timeline of the people, places and animals from 390 million years ago to today. The site was recently added to the Lewis and Clark National Historic Trail.

The Howard Steamboat Museum

Step into the Steamboat Era at the Howard Steamboat Museum. This beautiful 1894 mansion is open year-round, it offers both guided and self-guided tours.
