Jeffersonville, Heritage & Hands-On Fun

Late Morning / Midday, Arrival in Jeffersonville

Lunch (Jeffersonville)

Time to freshen up and enjoy a relaxed welcome meal before the touring begins.

Howard Steamboat Museum, Guided Tour (Jeffersonville)

A National Historic Landmark mansion showcasing the legacy of the Howard family, once the world's leading steamboat builders. The guided tour highlights river history, craftsmanship, and elegant Victorian-era rooms.

Schimpff's Confectionery (Jeffersonville)

One of the oldest continuously operating candy businesses in the U.S. Groups enjoy a candy-making demonstration, a small museum explaining 19th-century confectionery, and time to shop for handmade sweets. This is an easy, crowd-pleasing stop.

Hotel Check-In (Jeffersonville / Clarksville / New Albany area)

Dinner (near hotel) in one of our walkable downtowns

Evening Experience, Pinot's Palette (Jeffersonville)

A relaxed, instructor-led paint-and-sip experience tailored for groups. Guests create a seasonal or themed painting step-by-step in a fun, social atmosphere. Ideal for fall evenings and a nice contrast to the historic touring earlier in the day.

Day 2

New Albany, Starlight, Borden, History, Harvest Flavors & Louisville Classic

Breakfast at Hotel

STOPS

- 1 Culbertson Mansion State Historic Site (New Albany)**
A stunning Second Empire–style mansion built in 1867. The guided tour explores ornate interiors, period furnishings, and stories of the Culbertson family, providing an excellent window into Indiana’s post-Civil War prosperity.
- 2 Downtown New Albany Free Time**
Strollable historic downtown with gift shops, boutiques, and coffee stops along the Ohio River.
Fall bonus: If touring in October, this time can align with Harvest Homecoming, Southern Indiana’s signature fall festival.
- 3 Lunch (New Albany)**
- 4 Huber’s Orchard and Winery (Borden / Starlight)**
A classic fall group stop featuring apple orchards, a farm market, winery and distillery, and seasonal activities. Guests can sample local products, shop for gifts, and enjoy the autumn atmosphere—one of the most popular fall attractions in Southern Indiana.
- 5 Early Dinner at Joe Huber’s Family Farm and Restaurant (Borden / Starlight)**
- 6 Evening Highlight, Louisville Jack O’Lantern Spectacular (Louisville)**
Held at Iroquois Park, this nationally recognized fall event features thousands of intricately carved pumpkins displayed along a themed, illuminated walking trail. A memorable seasonal experience that consistently rates as a tour highlight.

Clarksville, Jeffersonville, Natural and Modern History & Departure

Breakfast at Hotel & Check-Out

STOPS

- 1 Falls of the Ohio State Park & Interpretive Center (Clarksville)**
Home to one of the world's largest exposed Devonian fossil beds. The Interpretive Center offers indoor exhibits and river views, while outdoor access allows guests to see 390-million-year-old fossils (conditions permitting). Educational, scenic, and easy for groups.
- 2 Vintage Fire Museum & Safety Education Center (Jeffersonville)**
A specialized museum featuring antique firefighting equipment, engines, and hands-on exhibits focused on fire safety and community history.

Late Morning, Lunch & Departure

Group lunch in Jeffersonville or Clarksville or boxed lunches for the journey home.
