

Day 1

Clarksville & Jeffersonville, Natural History & Dinner Theatre

Late Morning – Arrival in Southern Indiana

STOPS

- 1 Lunch along the Ohio River (Clarksville or Jeffersonville)**
- 2 Falls of the Ohio State Park (Clarksville)**
Explore one of the world's largest exposed Devonian fossil beds dating back 390 million years, with an interpretive center highlighting geology, river history, and native wildlife.
- 3 Vintage Fire Museum & Safety Education Center (Jeffersonville)**
A specialized museum featuring antique firefighting equipment, engines, and hands-on exhibits focused on fire safety and community history.
- 4 Derby Dinner Playhouse (Clarksville)**
Enjoy a full meal paired with a professional Broadway-style musical or comedy in a comfortable dinner-theatre setting.

Day 2

New Albany, Underground Railroad, Heritage & Interactive Dining

STOPS

- 1 The Floyd County Carnegie Library Cultural Arts Center (New Albany)**
Visit a nationally recognized exhibit interpreting New Albany's significant role in the Underground Railroad through stories of freedom seekers and local abolitionists.
- 2 Town Clock Church / Second Baptist Church (New Albany)**
A historic 1852 church with documented Underground Railroad connections, offering insight into the faith-based networks that supported freedom seekers.
- 3 Other Underground Railroad Attractions & Downtown Walk (New Albany)**
Time for guided walking exploration of additional Underground Railroad-related sites, riverfront areas, and historic downtown streets tied to escape routes across the Ohio River.
- 4 Schimpff's Confectionery (Jeffersonville)**
A family-owned candy shop operating since 1891, known for hand-made red hots, cinnamon candy, demonstrations, and nostalgic treats.
- 5 MESA: A Live Dining Show (Jeffersonville)**
An immersive culinary and theatrical experience where guests enjoy multi-course dining paired with live performance and storytelling.

Day 3

River Heritage & Festival or Cruise Option

STOPS

- 1 Howard Steamboat Museum (Jeffersonville)**
Tour an 1894 Victorian mansion built by the Howard family, leaders in American steamboat construction, featuring river history and period furnishings.
- 2 Belle of Louisville River Cruise (Louisville Waterfront)**
A narrated sightseeing or dining cruise aboard one of America's oldest operating riverboats, offering scenic views and river lore along the Ohio River.
- 3 Seasonal Feature, Memorial Day Weekend, Abbey Road on the River (Jeffersonville)**
A multi-day outdoor music festival celebrating Beatles and classic rock tribute bands, held annually over Memorial Day weekend along the riverfront.

Departure, Mid to Late Afternoon
