Remember these valuable tips to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience—here in the ATL Airport District and anywhere else you may travel.

AIRPORT RECOMMENDATIONS

- Laptops, computers, iPads and other devices should be placed in carry-on baggage. Do not place them in your checked baggage. When placing them in your carry-on baggage, position them in a way that you can easily remove them at the security checkpoint.
- Event programs and magazines should be placed in your carry-on baggage to expedite screening procedures. Please ensure they are easily accessible should they need to be physically inspected.
- If using a lock, we recommend you purchase a TSA accessible lock to place on all checked baggage.

GENERAL SAFETY

- If you see someone acting suspicious or see something suspicious, say something. Call 9-1-1 immediately.
- Always be aware of your surroundings and know your location.
- Travel in pairs or groups when walking. Identify a meeting point in advance or let someone know where you plan to be in the event that you get separated.
- Do not carry any unnecessary valuables with you and never leave your bags or possessions unattended.
- Upon leaving a meeting or convention, be sure to remove your attendee badge and either put it away or recycle it with a staff member before leaving the building.
- Never write your hotel room number on your room key.
- If parking, lock your vehicle and never leave valuables or personal items on display.
- Deposit your valuables in the hotel safe and keep an inventory of what was deposited. Never leave cash or other valuables in your room.
- Required by Georgia law, all drivers must practice hands-free mobile phone usage.
