





















COLUMBIA MUSEUM OF ART

Able to accommodate parties ranging from 10–1,400 this venue has unique touches, like exclusive special exhibitions and an outdoor plaza at the center of Main Street, making for captivating backdrops.

CITY ROOTS

Stage your event under a covered pavilion and twinkly string lights amidst rows of farm land at City Roots. HISTORIC COLUMBIA

HARVEST DINNER AT **CITY ROOTS**

STONE RIVER

Greenway from Stone River's large windows that overlook the city skyline. With stone accents, a built-in bar and a wrap-around porch, your guests will feel right at home while attending an event here.

CENTRAL ENERGY

Central Energy is one of Columbia's newest venues with over 8,000 square feet of social space. Formerly the central power plant for the historic SC State Hospital, it was designed as a blank canvas with industrial and modern touches to help bring your personal vision to life.

SEGRA PARK

With the option for an indoor or outdoor space and capacity ranging from 30 to 400 guests, **Segra Park** is optimal for any group seeking a venue with various size vistas and space with a view.

JUNCTION 800

Smack in the middle of The Vista entertainment district, you'll find Junction 800. As a large room with a built-in bar and funky light fixtures, it's a blank space that's flexible for any needs of up to 500 seated and 1,000 standing. Bonus – their exclusive caterer, Southern Way Catering, has been serving the Columbia area for 35 years and is one of the best in the business.

LACE HOUSE

Southern charm abounds at this historic house turned event space. Surrounded by gardens and tucked away courtyards, it's the perfect spot for an elevated, yet contemporary event. Not to mention, the team behind this venue is well-versed in events of all sizes.


PASTIDES ALUMNI CENTER AT UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH CAROLINA

With modern architecture and state of the art technology, the Pastides Alumni Center has 30,000 square feet of finely crafted event space. It serves as the backdrop to small training sessions and cocktail parties to large conferences and breathtaking weddings, with its stunning grand staircase and spacious main ballroom.

TOWNSHIP AUDITORIUM

With a 3,000 person capacity for concert seating and a 50 foot wide stage, the **Township** is the perfect setting for larger general sessions. It's got all the charm of a historic building with columns that line the front and a proscenium stage that frames the performers in a regal welcoming.

UNEXPECTED FOODIE TOWN

THE COLUMBIA FOOD SCENE IS BUZZING

with new and exciting restaurants popping up all the time, while seasoned chefs continue to marvel diners with their culinary creations. When the meeting wraps, grab the team, and explore the capital city one bite at a time. Need a recommendation? Try one of these local favorites.

MARKET ON MAIN

Market on Main offers a place to comfortably enjoy every season in Columbia, with a cocktail to match. Their lush patio offers heated igloos in the winter, sun coverings in the spring, and college football on a projector in the fall. With ingredients straight from the indoor market, their menu has a wide variety of everything, from vegan meals to four different styles of Waygu beef.

SMOKED

For an elevated dining experience, make your way to **Smoked** in the Main Street district. Here, you'll find decadent dishes featuring smoked meats, oysters, and even smoked drinks. Housed in a reimagined 19th century mercantile, the atmosphere is just as unique as the creations they serve.

BLUE MARLIN

Just down the street from the Columbia Metropolitan Center, you'll find Blue Marlin. Merging African, West Indian and Caribbean flavors with Cajun and Creole dishes, Blue Marlin showcases the diversity of Southern cuisine. Located in an old train station, Blue Marlin has been pulling in locals and visitors since 1994.

KIKI'S CHICKEN & WAFFLES

The Columbia region's first dedicated chicken-and-waffle destination, Kiki's Chicken and Waffles has been serving homemade soul food for more than five years. This is your go-to spot for wings piled high atop French Toast, or red velvet waffles. For lunch or dinner, try fish and waffles or the fried shrimp platter.

PUBLICO KITCHEN & TAP

For a more casual setting, **Publico Kitchen & Tap** is serving up Lat-Asian inspired dishes with margarita flights on the side. Head to their hidden patio for yard games, camaraderie, and lots of furry friends.







BLACK ROOSTER

Across the river in West Columbia is the modern and "Frenchish" Black Rooster. Here the menu ranges from entrees like the Royale with Cheese and Vietnamese Mussels, and plenty of small plate options like Le Grilled Cheese and Beef Tartare, portioned just right for when you want bites to share. Best part? You can snap a pic of the mouth-watering creations and the city skyline in one shot on the rooftop which has one of the best views of downtown Columbia.

RAMBO'S FAT CAT BISICUITS

This breakfast joint is taking biscuit making to the next level. Goat cheese, smoked brisket, and mac & cheese are just a few of the fixings you'll catch on their menu, but their pimento cheese is one of their most popular. If pimento cheese is your love language, you can explore some of the region's best offerings through our Pimento Cheese Passport (Rambo's Fat Cat Biscuits is one of seventeen restaurants featured!).

COA AGAVERIA Y COCINA

After a stroll through Columbia SC's vibrant art district, the Vista, swing by COA for equally vibrant cocktails and tapas. Here they take crafted to a whole new level. While their menu is packed with thoughtfully created dishes, the tacos are a must.

SPOTTED SALAMANDER

For a quick bite with lots of Southern flare, head to **Spotted Salamander**. Their fresh salads (the Spotted Salad is a must-try) and sandwiches make for the perfect lunch, but a visit would be remiss without an order of their deviled eggs, famous among locals and visitors alike.

HENDRIX

Swanky decor, specialty cocktails, and a rooftop bar overlooking Main Street is what you'll find at this popular restaurant. Hendrix offers one-ofa-kind shareable dishes and main courses made from sustainable, locally, and ethically sourced ingredients.





MUST DOS IN COLUMBIA SC

BREWERIES

It's no secret that craft beer is gaining in popularity across the nation. With a mix of breweries (11 and counting!), brew pubs, and biergartens, Columbia's beer scene is no different. Firmly rooted in a homegrown spirit, each has its own character, giving you a unique venue for a memorable reception, or a happy hour spot for attendees after the meeting wraps. Check out local favorites like Steel Hands Brewing in Cayce or Columbia Craft located in The Vista.



ATTRACTIONS

RIVERBANKS ZOO & GARDEN

Our attractions are the perfect way to while away a few hours in the city. For the art lovers, the Columbia Museum of Art boasts an impressive permanent collection in addition to exciting rotating exhibits. Take in history and culture by stopping by the South Carolina State Museum. With four floors of exhibits on South Carolina history, art, natural history and science and technology to the state-of-the-art observatory and dome planetarium, to the interactive experience of the 4D theater, guests will not be bored. Or, visit the house & garden district with guided tours from Historic Columbia. Explore your inner wild child at Riverbanks Zoo & Garden. hands- down one of the nation's prettiest and most interactive zoos, and home to 2,000 animals in habitat as well as an ever-growing State Botanical Garden. The capital city is also home to EdVenture, the South's largest children's museum that houses EDDIE, the world's largest child.



PUBLIC ART

Columbia is filled with an abundance of walls, parks, courtyards and street corners with murals, and sculptures, just waiting to be found. Much of Columbia's public art is displayed indoors as well. Don't expect to find typical convention center art on the walls of Columbia Metropolitan Convention Center. Instead, the light-filled space is filled with abstract landscapes, montages, light-catching glass sculptures and paintings of local landmarks so realistic that they could be photographs.



OUTDOOR ADVENTURE

The heart of SC lies at the confluence of the Saluda and Broad Rivers, which merge right in town to form the Congaree. The region is flush with parks and opportunities for outdoor adventures. Explore the trails of Three Rivers Greenway, spend the day on the water at Lake Murray, or go hiking at Congaree National Park, South Carolina's only national park. With so much natural beauty nearby, you can escape the bustling city and get lost in your thoughts amidst fresh air and cool waters in next to no time flat.



GAME TIME

Nothing brings people together quite like sports. From collegiate games to a professional baseball team, you and your attendees can become local fans for the day and root for the home team. Home to the University of South Carolina Gamecocks, you can catch a football game at Williams-Brice Stadium or watch the men and women's basketball teams take on their opponents at Colonial Life Arena, located right next to the convention center. In the spring, you can cheer on the Columbia Fireflies, our minor league baseball team, at Segra Park where there's not a bad seat in the house.







