Columbia Christmas Parade & Tree Lighting

Saturday, December 2, 2023 | Parade: 6:00 PM | Tree Lighting: 7:15-ish

- Application Deadline: Nov 17, 2023. No Entries accepted after this date. Maximum of 4 floats per application please.
- NEW THIS YEAR: PARADE FEE is \$25 per application.
 Submit with application. Check or Cash.
- Rain date: Saturday, December 9th at 6:00 PM
- 4:30 PM: Parade lineup begins all entries must be in place by 5:30 PM (This includes both judged and non-judged entries.)
- 5:45 PM: Parade lineup closes staging area secured with no further access permitted
- 6:00 PM: Parade begins at Trotwood/W 7th St split and travels east to Courthouse Square; Tree Lighting festivities will begin approximately 15 minutes after parade ends.
- This is a nighttime parade so holiday decorations & lights are expected & appropriate holiday music is encouraged. No decorating theme is required.
- No substitute floats permitted unless approved 48 hours prior to the parade.
- The traditional staging area is along W 7th Street in front of Columbia Academy and east to the Trotwood Avenue split.
 The parade route begins at the Trotwood/W 7th Street split and goes downtown beyond the East side of the Maury County Courthouse.
- The parade will be followed by the annual Tree Lighting on the Square. Upon completing the parade, procession participants can walk back to the Courthouse Square for the tree lighting.
- The Final parade entry is <u>Mr. and Mrs. Santa Clause</u>. No other entry may have a Santa character present on their float.
- Judged winners will be announced at the Tree Lighting following the parade.
- All parade entrants will be emailed final details prior to the event.
- NEW THIS YEAR: Parade float entries will not have a preset number for lineup. DAY OF PARADE: Entries will be checked in, receive their lineup number and be lined up on a first-come, first-served basis (with the exception of marching bands). If the entire party of parade float vehicles is not together upon arrival, participants for that entry will be placed in a holding spot until the entire party is on site.

- The parade will begin at 6:00 PM & proceed along W 7th Street to the east side of the Courthouse Square.
- The parade must move continuously with NO stopping.
- Upon completion of the parade, all motorized entries will exit at E 7th Street and all walking entries will exit at North Main Street. No stopping or dismounting allowed until you have cleared beyond the exit streets.
- Parade participants are encouraged to come back to the Courthouse Square, after completing the parade, to attend the annual Tree Lighting.
- Parade participant pick-up must be scheduled in advance.
 Parking lots near the Courthouse Square at Woodland
 Street, W 6th Street, or Columbia City Hall may be used for pick-up.
- No youth participants are to be left unattended at any time.
- The Columbia Police Department and the official parade staff will govern parade activities.
- The parade typically lasts 1 to 1.5 hours.
- Display lineup numbers in a prominent place on the front of the parade entry.
- It is not permitted to throw candy or other items from parade floats. You may have a 'walker' accompany your float to hand out candy, but no contact can be made between the walker and the float at any time.
- Profanity or suggestive audio, video, graphics, or signage is not permitted.
- Absolutely no jumping on or off floats while in motion.
- Motorcycles and vehicles must have an adequate muffler in constant operation, properly maintained to prevent any excessive or unusual noise.
- Maintain a slow, steady pace along the parade route, proceeding in a forward direction at all times, with at least 10 feet of distance between floats.
- No stopping for performances permitted.
- No consumption of alcohol permitted.
- Only pre-approved animal entries are permitted.
- Exercise extreme caution at all times, especially in the use of generators.
- Cancellation due to weather will be announced by 11:00 AM the day of the event through the City of Columbia's Facebook page & website and rain date will observed.


