



FEES & GUIDELINES

FEES

Standard Softball Fields

- \$100 per field/per day, including lights
- \$55 per additional drag of field/per time
- \$15 per bag: conditioner, dry mix, etc.
- \$50 per game for games starting at 11:00 p.m. or later

Championship Softball Field with 1,200 Stadium Seating and Press Box

- \$250 per field/per day, including lights
- \$55 per additional drag of field/per time
- \$15 per bag: conditioner, dry mix, etc.
- \$50 per game for games starting at 11:00 p.m. or later

Rectangular Fields for Soccer, Lacrosse, Rugby and Football

- \$100 per field/per day, including lights
- \$50 per game for games starting at 11:00 p.m. or later

Championship Rectangular Field with 1,200 Stadium Seating and Press Box

- \$250 per day, including lights
- Goal/goalpost and laser-graded fields to promote surface water runoff
- \$50 per game/per day for games starting at 11:00 p.m. or later

RESERVATIONS

First come, first serve basis. Applications must be completed and **\$200.00** deposit is required to reserve your date(s) on the calendar. This deposit will be applied toward the total amount of fees due to the City of Columbia.

INSURANCE

Proof of liability insurance in the amount of \$2,000,000 naming the City of Columbia as additionally insured must be submitted 30 calendar days prior to the scheduled tournament date.

SANCTIONING REQUIREMENTS

Either, ASA, USSSA, and ISA, NSA or another sports organization, must sanction all tournaments being held at Ridley Sports Complex. The tournament director must provide proof that the tournament has been sanctioned and identify the organization.

Tournament umpires must be sanctioned and belong to an umpire association which is affiliated with one of the following sports associations. (ASA, ISA, NSA, USGF or other national softball accredited organizations)
