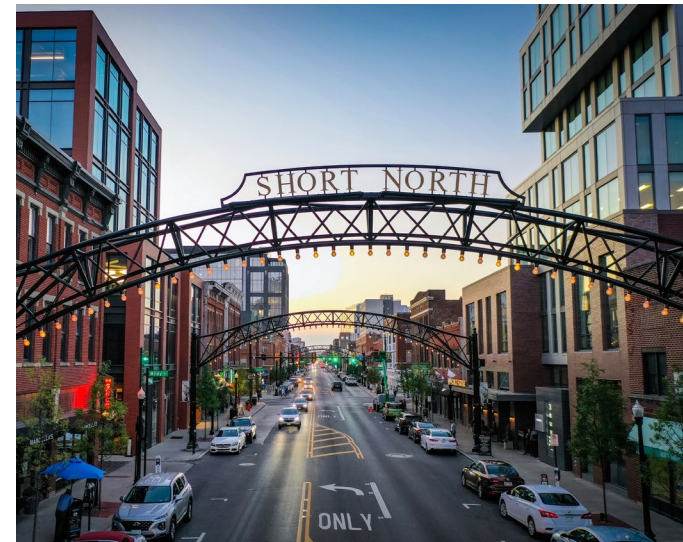

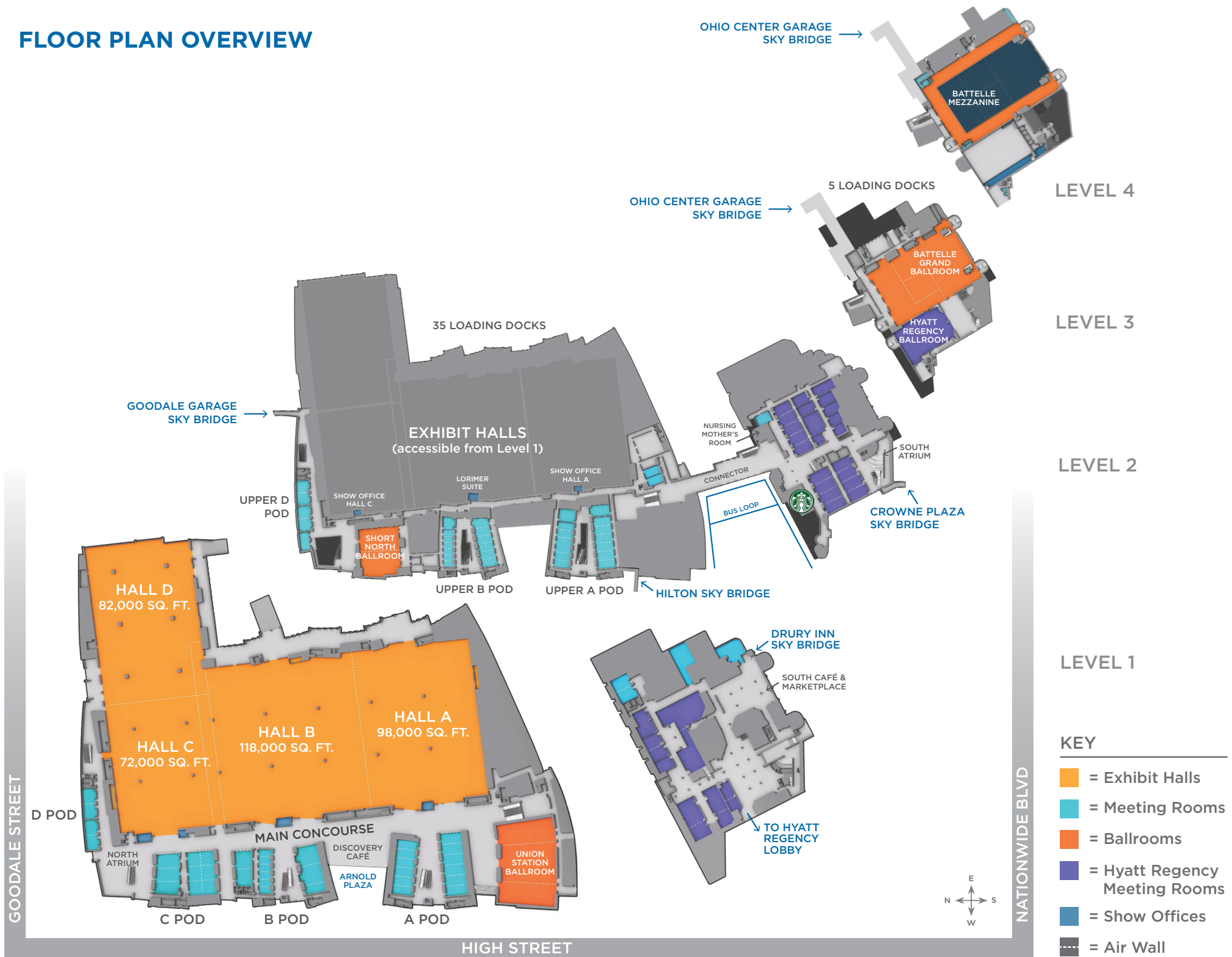

14th Largest City in the Country

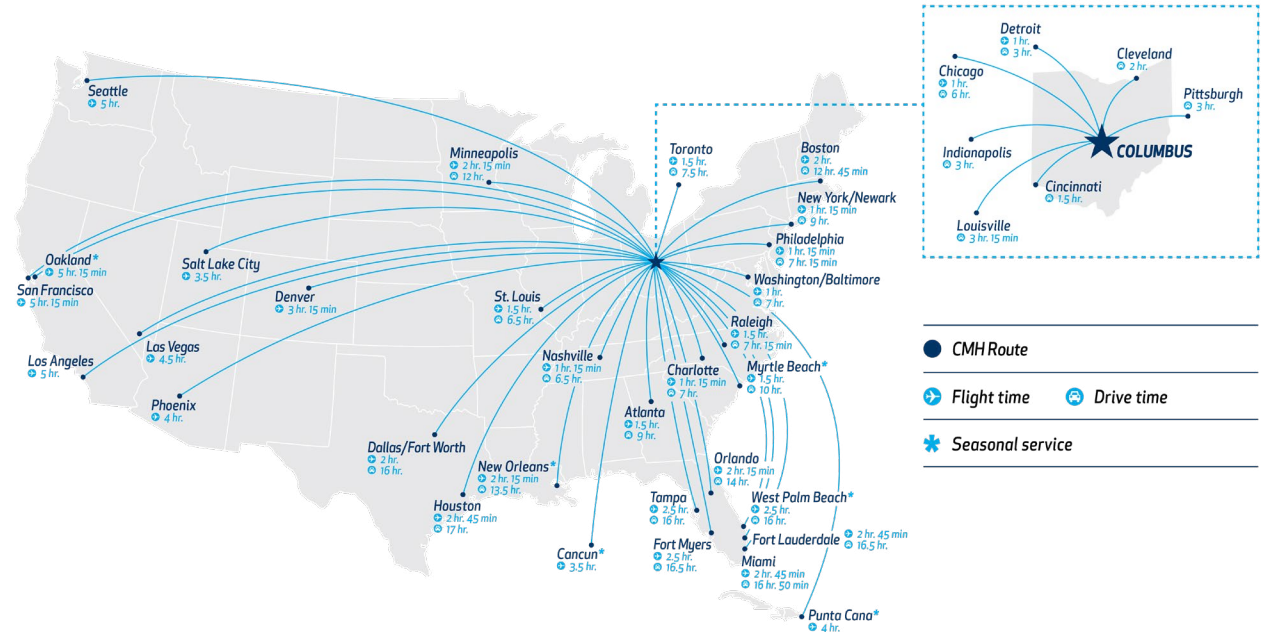
One of the nation's most creative, exciting and forward-thinking cities, Columbus is celebrated for its incredible arts, entertainment, fashion and culinary offerings.

ACCESSIBLE

Nearly half of the U.S. population is within a **one-hour flight or one-day drive** of Columbus.

John Glenn Columbus International Airport is just **10 minutes from downtown** and offers more than **150 daily, nonstop departures to more than 40 destinations**. **AirConnect buses** circulate every 30 minutes between the airport, downtown hotels and the convention center.

Columbus is located at the **crossroads of two major interstate highways**: I-70 and I-71. As a result, many attendees can easily drive.



WALKABLE

Columbus is an easy, walkable convention destination with **galleries, shops, dining, nightlife, sports and hotels across the street from the convention center** in the Short North Arts District and Arena District. Downtown, Franklinton, the Brewery District and German Village are within 10 blocks of the center or 10 stops on the **free CBUS Downtown Circulator**.
