RECOVERY AND SAFETY IN COLUMBUS

As we welcome sports events back to our city, Columbus is dedicated to working alongside community partners to create seamless safety protocols while following local, state and federal public health requirements. Here's what you need to know about Columbus' commitment to safely hosting your event.

DOES COLUMBUS HAVE A MASK MANDATE?

Yes, wearing a mask in Columbus is mandatory for anyone over the age of six in all public spaces where six feet of social distancing cannot be maintained. The mandate exempts those who are strenuously exercising. Read the full ordinance and its exemptions <u>here</u>. Similar mandates exist across the entirety of Franklin County.

HOW MANY PEOPLE ARE PERMITTED AT EVENTS IN COLUMBUS?

As Ohio continues reopening during the COVID-19 pandemic, mass gatherings are still prohibited where social distancing is not possible. New state mandates permit sports and entertainment venues to reopen with 25% of maximum indoor capacity and 30% maximum outdoor capacity, provided they follow <u>established safety protocols</u> such as social distancing and mask wearing. Venues may opt to follow their own attendance guidelines under this mandate.

CAN COLUMBUS HELP PROVIDE PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE) FOR MY EVENT?

Yes! The Greater Columbus Sports Commission (Sports Commission) and Experience Columbus can provide you with a list of <u>local partners</u> that are producing essential reopening products and PPE. The Greater Columbus Convention Center operates its own <u>PPE Resource Center</u> that includes face shields, masks, sanitizing equipment and more.
