

## Arena District: A One-Day Itinerary

**Stay | Canopy by Hilton**: Check into the Canopy by Hilton, which boasts a contemporary design, an excellent location, an onsite restaurant, and a rooftop bar called Goodale Station.

## Brunch | Moran's Bar & Grille:

Brunch it up at Moran's Bar & Grille and feast on some of your favorites like Steak & Eggs, the Chef's Omelet and Bottomless Mimosas.

Morning Activity | McFerson Commons Park: Take a stroll through one of the district's most picturesque greenspaces, recognizable by the Union Station Arch, which perfectly frames the park on the south entrance.
