Apps: Lyft for iPhone and Android
Cost: Single Ride: Classic bike - \$2.25 for 30mins, then \$0.15/min; Ebike - \$2.25 to unlock, then \$0.15/min.
Day Pass: Classic bike - \$8 for 30min rides, then \$0.15/min; Ebike - \$8 for free unlocks, then \$0.15/min.

Columbus' bike share system, with 600+ bikes at 80+ stations throughout Columbus, Bexley, Grandview Heights, Upper Arlington and Easton. Available for use 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Supercharge your ride with the pedal-assisted Ebike. See station locations on Lyft app or website.

Apps: Bird for iPhone and Android
Cost: Scooters: \$1 to unlock, then \$0.45/min + tax and fees; 30-minute day pass \$7.99, 90-minute three-day pass \$17.99

Cost: Monthly membership \$9 + driving rates from \$11/hr and \$91.50/day. \$25 application fee also required.

Zipcar gives you on-demand access to drive cars by the hour or day. Apply online and when you're approved, you'll be able to book cars instantly. Download and use the app to unlock and start your trip. Park it back in its dedicated parking spot, then lock up in the app. It's that easy!

**Note: you'll receive a ZipCar card in the mail you can use to lock and unlock your trip.*
