More than 60,000 fans attended the U.S. Figure Skating Championships which captured headlines globally. Creative collaborations with local partners helped elevate the event and reached new corners of our community.


In the spring, we hosted three NCAA Championships and were home to one of the most highly demanded stops on the Savannah Bananas World Tour.

The world's game came to our city during the Summer of Soccer highlighted by the MLS All-Star Game and Manchester City vs. Chelsea. Additionally, the USA Fencing National Championships were the largest event in the sports history with 6,200+ competitors, and we hosted more than 400 teams at the USA Volleyball Adult Open National Championships.

The year wrapped up with the first-ever women's pro pickleball event, a women's NCAA ice hockey tournament and the College Football Playoff First Round.


From the U.S. Figure Skating Championships in January through the College Football Playoff in December, the sports schedule was stacked.


