Overview

Cook County is a treasured vacation destination in Minnesota, especially for outdoor enthusiasts. Home to the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness, the shores of Lake Superior, four state parks, Lutsen Mountains, and the Grand Portage Lodge and Casino, visitors flock year-round to the region.


To understand the value visitors bring to the county's economy, Visit Cook County asked <u>University of Minnesota Extension</u> to estimate the economic impact of visitors. This is a summary of the research findings.

Visitor Traffic

- On average, *1.2 million visitors* arrive in Cook County, Minnesota each year.
- Visitation peaked in 2020 as Minnesotans spent more time engaged in outdoor activities and/or visiting cabins and second homes.

Total spending by Cook County visitors in 2022




Average spend per visitor per day

Economic Impact Effects



- **Direct effects** are the initial change in the economy. In this analysis, it is the spending by visitors in Cook County.
- Indirect and induced effects are the economic activity generated at businesses throughout the county, even if they are not patronized by the visitors. For example, Cook County visitors may not hire a local accountant, but that accountant might have a client whose business caters to visitors.

In total, Cook County visitors generated an estimated \$220 million of economic activity in 2022. This includes \$69 million in labor income, or money into the pockets of Cook County workers.

Visitors supported 2,060 jobs. Of those, 1,700 workers directly serve visitors, and 360 workers are at businesses that support the tourism industry.



Of the \$220 million in economic activity generated by visitors was at businesses that do not directly serve visitors.

The industries beyond direct service that benefited the most from visitors include real estate, government enterprises (including state, local, and tribal operations), and utilities.







State & Local Tax Impacts





Employment


Top Employment Industry By County | 2022

Cook County is one of a handful of counties in Minnesota where the leisure and hospitality industry accounts for the highest share of jobs. Other counties include Cass, Lake of the Woods, Mahnomen, and Pine.

Retail Impact




in retail sales per resident

Cook County has the highest amount of taxable retail and service sales per capita in the state.

Cook County had slightly less than \$23,000 in sales per resident in 2021. This figure is calculated by taking total retail sales and dividing by the population.

Of all sales are attributed to visitors.

Tourism is a major contributor to Cook County retail and service sales. Across all categories, visitor spending accounted for 87% of retail and service spending. Visitors accounted for more than 90% of sales in the lodging, transportation, and shopping sectors in Cook County in 2022.

Key Findings



- On average, *1.2 million visitors* arrive in Cook County, Minnesota each year.
- In 2022, estimated visitor spending was \$164
 Million in sales across all sectors generating
 \$28 Million in state and local taxes.
- The tourism industry impacts 8 out of 10 jobs in the community *directly supporting 2,060 jobs*.
- Cook County is *#1 in taxable sales* in Minnesota per capita.
