

THREE-TIME OLYMPIAN. USA CHAMPIONSHIP TITLIST. USATF ATHLETE OF THE YEAR.

Deena is an Olympic Bronze medalist and the American record holder in the marathon (2:19.36). Since beginning her professional career in 1997, Deena has held American records in every distance, from the 5K to the marathon. She has represented the USA on 19 national teams. Deena also earned two silver medals in the World Cross Country Championships and has 24 national titles to her name. As a master runner (over 40 years old) she has broken five world records and seven American records, including the marathon.



In 2019, Deena wrote a New York Times Bestseller and 2019 Memoir of the Year, *Let Your Mind Run A Memoir of Thinking My Way to Victory*. “I am thrilled to be a part of this year’s Wineglass Weekend, said Kastor. “There is nothing better than seeing a community come together to celebrate the sport of running, which has such a positive effect on all our lives.”

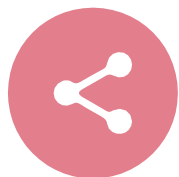

It truly takes a village to ensure all Wineglass events run safely and successfully, and few are more critical than our safety partners.

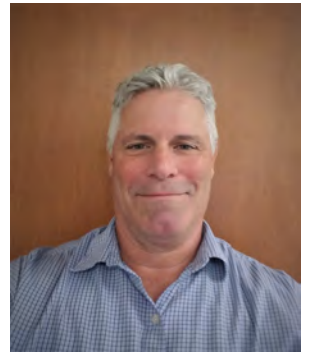

Runners are strongly urged to board the earlier buses. Shelter is available at both start locations. Arriving near the end of scheduled buses impacts the capacity of the transport, the safety of other runners, our staff/volunteers, and the start of the race

RUNNER DROP-OFF CORNING

TRANSPORTATION CENTER, 85 Denison Parkway East

Drivers dropping off runners are encouraged to enter Corning from Route 352 via exits 45 and 47. Exit 46 will be heavily congested due to bus traffic and race parking.

RUNNER DROP-OFF BATH

FROM I-86 WESTBOUND (Corning) - Take Exit 39. Turn right at bottom of ramp and travel straight ahead toward Bath for approximately 1.8 miles (road becomes SR415 - E. Morris St. and then E. Steuben St.). For runner drop-off, Pulteney Square will be on your left, and parking will be on your right.

FROM I-86 EASTBOUND (towards Corning) - Take Exit 38. Turn left at bottom of ramp on SR54 toward Bath. At stop light, continue straight ahead onto SR54/415 (W. Washington St.) for approximately 0.6 miles into the village of Bath. Turn right onto Liberty St. (SR415) and follow for two blocks to Steuben St. For runner drop, turn right onto W. Steuben St. to drop off at Pulteney Square.

FROM 54S - Continue straight on 54 into Village of Bath. 54 becomes Liberty St. which ends at Pulteney Square. Turn right onto W. Steuben St. for runner drop-off. Turn left onto E. Steuben St. for parking.


