Distance 9.2 miles

A perfect ride and ecotour for the family on quiet country roads, surrounded by state forest lands, and lovely little lakes.

Enjoy a picnic at the Sanford Lake Day Use Area. Rustic camping is also available at Sanford Lake. Park your bikes and take a walk along a self-guided Forest Stewardship Demonstration Tour. The adults will delight in gentle glides past beautifully restored historic homes. The entire family can enjoy ice cream and miniature golf at the seven mile mark! A quintessential Finger Lakes ride.

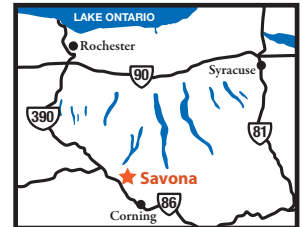

Directions: START at the Campbell-Savona Elementary School parking lot. (.3 miles north on Rt. 226 from intersection of Rt. 415 and Rt. 226 in Savona.)

Turn LEFT out of parking lot onto Rt. 226.

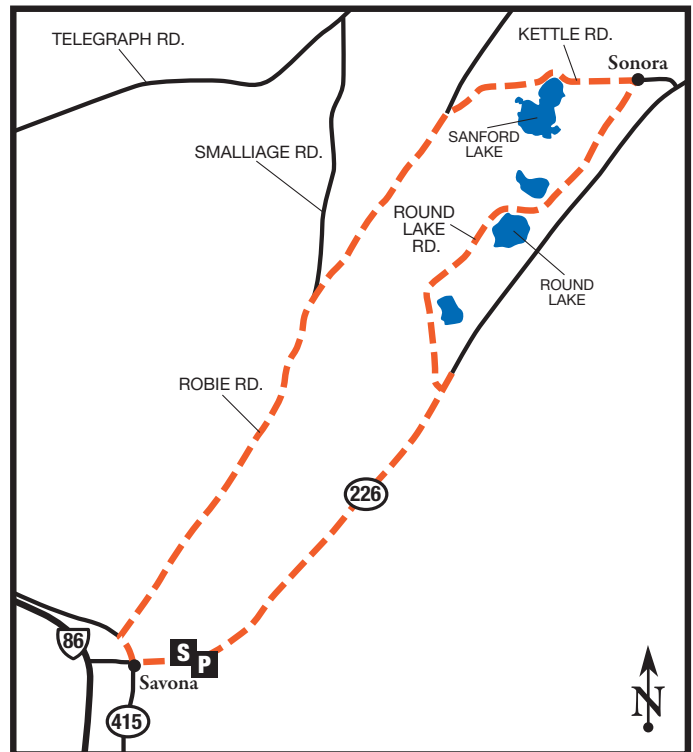
Turn RIGHT at intersection onto Rt. 415 (.3)

Turn RIGHT onto Robie Road (.1) Continue on Robie Road past the intersection with Veilie Road (2.1) Stop at the Forest Stewardship Demonstration Tour Stop. No. 1 (.5) Continue on Robie Road to the intersection of Kettle and Robie roads (.8).

Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto Kettle Road. Nice downhill and around one side of Sanford Lake. Peddle slight uphill grade to Sonora (1.0)

Turn RIGHT onto the Round Lake Road. Continue on the Round Lake Road past Round Lake to the entrance to Sanford Lake Day Use Area. (1.1) This is a nice place for a picnic. Resume ride on Round Lake Road to intersection with Rt. 226 (1.1)

Turn LEFT to enjoy ice cream at Cream of the Crop (.1) or turn RIGHT onto Rt. 226 to return to the Campbell-Savona Elementary School (2.0).
