### How to participate:

- Pre-carve your pumpkin at home. Carve as many as you like. Please keep carvings family friendly. The Days of Incandescence event team maintains the right to refuse to display any carvings that we feel are inappropriate for public display.
- Bring your carved pumpkin to the Days of Incandescence festival at Riverfront Park by 5pm 10/29/22
- Light your Jack-o-Lantern with a battery-operated led candle or light (no fire/open flames/wick candles or glass votives allowed)
- Label your pumpkin on the back with your: full name (age is optional)
- You can choose to carve your pumpkin in one of our contest categories below and be entered in the carving contest for prizes
- Enjoy the glow of our community Jack-O-Lantern display and have fun at the Days of Incandescence Celebration with live music, entertainment and vendors.
- Take your Jack-o-Lantern back home when you leave

### Carving Contest Categories:

Days of Incandescence is a celebration of 1880's Corning history and mystery especially regarding Corning Glassworks part in the creation of Thomas Edison's light bulb. Carve your pumpkin in one of the locally-themed categories listed below to be entered in the carving contest and win prizes:
