Coast over and explore the trail to see how these contributions strengthened the nation's defense and secured a victory.

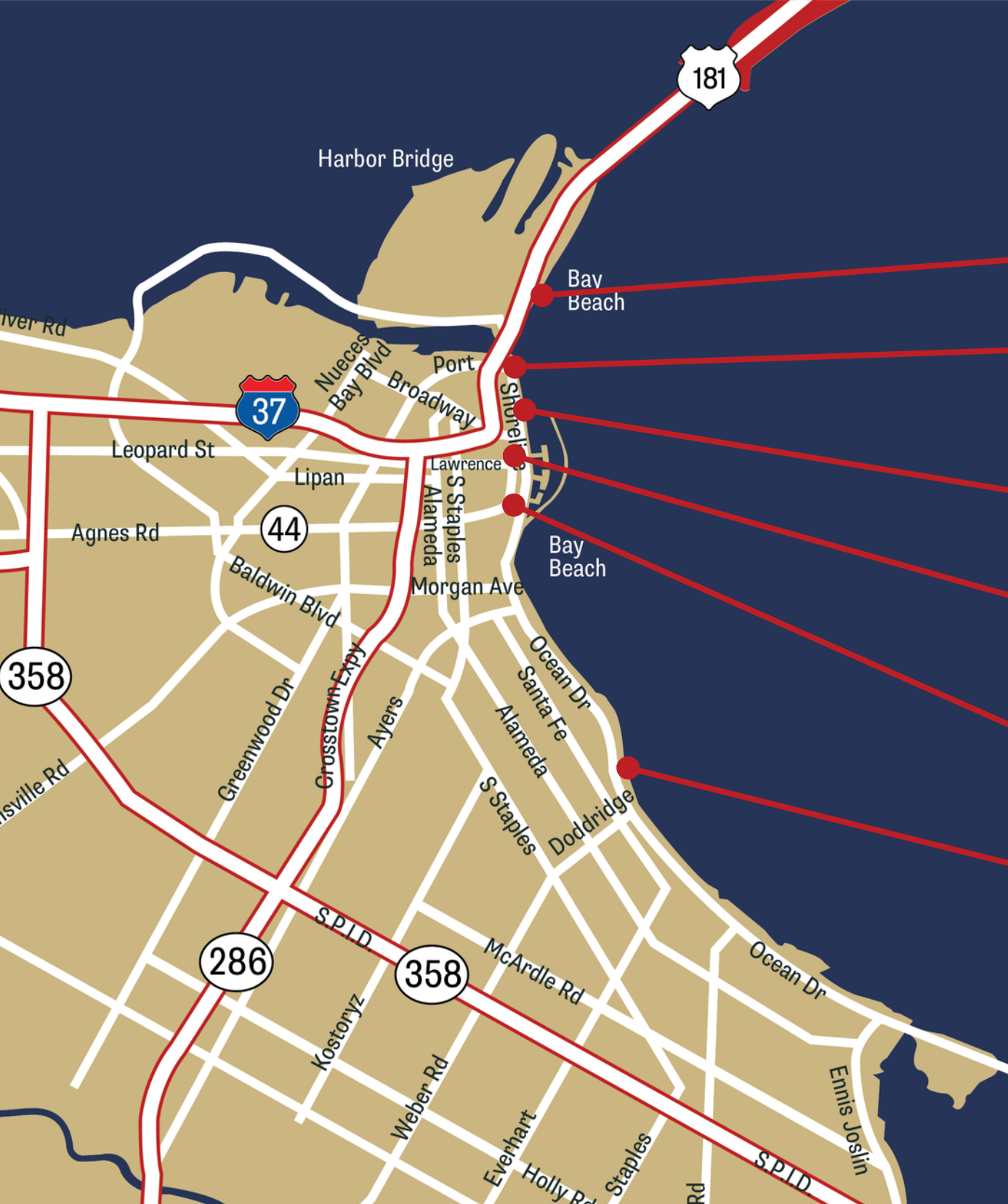
