

A day in Coventry

With so much to see and do here in Coventry, there is a lot to fit in. Here's an itinerary for visiting some of the most notable historical and heritage sites in Coventry and exploring all the city has to offer!



Morning

Coventry Cathedral where Old Meets New. Start your day at Coventry Cathedral, where the **medieval ruins meet the modern cathedral**. Explore the history and artistry, plus **Bayley Lane**, a preserved medieval street beside the cathedral ruins. Step inside **St Michael's Gallery** and explore the cathedral's story through its fascinating collections and displays.

Then move on to **St Mary's Guildhall for Award Winning History**. Visit this recently restored gem, home to the magnificent Coventry Tapestry and medieval interiors that reveal the city's rich past.

As you wander through the city streets you will meet **Lady Godiva** along the way, a sight for everyone to see.

Finish your morning at the **Herbert Art Gallery & Museum** and enjoy award-winning exhibitions and a packed events programme.

Afternoon

Make your way over to **Coventry Music Museum** where you can try your hand (and ears) at composing and music-making.

Stop for lunch at **Coombe Abbey Hotel** a stunning historic setting with great food, perfect for a relaxing break

Next wander to **FarGo Village** where you can stop and refuel in one of their independent cafés, bars. Or you may prefer to check out the outdoor area and have some street food. Browse the vintage shops and Indie Mart a treasure trove of retro finds, handmade goods, and unique pieces from local creators.

Finish your afternoon at **Charterhouse** and explore the acres of green space and its beautiful surroundings.

If you're a sports fan, catch the live sports scene in Coventry, from football with **Coventry City F.C.** to ice hockey with **Coventry Blaze** and rugby with **Coventry Rugby**. Check the match schedule ahead of your visit and experience the electric atmosphere of game day in the city.

Evening

As night falls enjoy some dinner and cocktails at **Dhillon's Spire Bar**. It's set inside a historic 13th century church spire that survived the Blitz.

Then head up to the rooftop bar at **Telegraph Hotel** for drinks with a view. Enjoy a relaxed atmosphere, stylish setting, and great city views

Lastly, finish the day at your choice of seeing a live performance at **hmv Empire** or dancing the night away at 147 Nightclub. The city is full of life and buzzing into the early hours. Or if a show is more your calling then head to **Albany Theatre, Belgrade Theatre** or **Warwick Arts Centre**.

Two days in Coventry

Should you be extending your stay in Coventry, then you'll want to know that you're making the most of your overnight stay.

Day one

Start your day at the **Herbert Art Gallery & Museum**, where Coventry's story unfolds from medieval times to the present through art, history, and interactive exhibits.

Then head to **Coventry Cathedral**. Take in its striking architecture, explore **St Michael's Gallery**, and step onto **Bayley Lane**, a preserved medieval street beside the cathedral ruins.

Visit the award winning **St Mary's Guildhall**. Continue through Broadgate to the Lady Godiva statue.

Discover the **Coventry Transport Museum**, with one of the UK's finest collections of British made road transport, from early bicycles to record breaking vehicles.

Enjoy lunch at Tales of Tea at **St Mary's Guildhall** or **Cogs at Hotel Indigo** before continuing to **FarGo Village**, known for indie shops and street food.

Then unwind at **Charterhouse**, a 600 year old Grade I listed site managed by the National Trust. If you're feeling indulgent, enjoy a tasting at **Blabers Hall Wine Estate** or a gin experience at **Vault 52** (advance booking needed).

For dinner, stay in the city at **Sky Blue Tavern** for a lively pub with a strong **Coventry City FC** spirit, or head just outside to **Twine at Ansty Hall** or **Ivy & Stone at Weston Hall**.

End the night with live music at **HMV Empire** or a night out at **147 Nightclub**. Coventry comes alive after dark.



Day two

Start your day with a hearty breakfast at **Coombe Abbey Hotel**, then soak up the fresh air with a wander through its stunning gardens and woodland trails or add a burst of adventure at **Go Ape Coombe Abbey**, where zip lines and rope bridges promise plenty of fun.

Discover the city's sound at the award winning **Coventry Music Museum**, where exhibits and stories bring Coventry's iconic music scene to life.

In the afternoon, escape to the countryside at **Heart of England Conference Centre**, set in rolling green space, then settle in for a cosy, feel good lunch at The Quicken Tree.

Back in the city, enjoy cocktails with a twist at **Dhillon's Spire Bar**, set inside a striking historic church spire, or head to **Generators Rooftop Bar** at **Telegraph Hotel** for relaxed drinks overlooking Belgrade Plaza.

Round off the evening your way catch live music at **hmv Empire**, dance into the early hours at **147 Nightclub**, or enjoy a show at **Belgrade Theatre**, **Albany Theatre**, or **Warwick Arts Centre**.
