Coventry is a city with a rich and diverse cultural heritage. Take a short walk to the **Coventry Music Museum**, a multi-award winning museum celebrates music from Coventry and Warwickshire in all its forms. Not just 2-Tone! From Delia Derbyshire to King, from The Specials to The Enemy, Hazel O'Connor, The Primitives and even the famous John Lennon Yoko Ono visit to Coventry are all exhibited here. Evening

End your day by catching a play or a musical and be immersed in Coventry's vibrant performing arts scene at one of Coventry's theatres. **Belgrade Theatre** is one of the largest regional producing theatres in the UK, with a wide variety of productions to choose from. **The Albany Theatre** is a historic and iconic. Originally opened in 1935, the theatre has undergone extensive renovation and refurbishment in recent years and is now a state-of-the-art venue for the performing arts.

After the show, grab a pint at one of Coventry's historic pubs or trendy bars, and toast to a day well spent in this culturally rich city.

Morning

Start your day with a visit to the **Coventry Cathedral**. Take a guided tour and marvel at the impressive modern architecture while learning about the cathedral's history and significance to the city.

Next, head to the **Herbert Art Gallery & Museum**, which showcases Coventry's cultural heritage through its extensive collection of art and artifacts. For the next three years, The Herbert Art Gallery & Museum will be home to **Dippy the Dinosaur**, a life-size, plaster-of-paris replica of a Diplodocus carnegii skeleton who is visiting from the Natural History Museum. Be sure to see him in Coventry while you can.

Afternoon

After a morning of exploring cultural landmarks, dive into Coventry's history by visiting one of the city's most historic buildings, **Charterhouse**. Explore three floors of immersive storytelling, surrounded by a halo of beautiful green space filled with wildlife, and a brand new café bar 'Purnell's at Charterhouse'.
