
## Crystal Coast, North Carolina

Why you'll love it: Located along North Carolina's central shore, the Crystal Coast has been a favorite beach destination for generations and represents one of the few remaining natural barrier island systems in the world with 85 miles of sparkling beaches. Base yourself near Beaufort, a 300-year-old town filled with pirate lore (Blackbeard's sunken flagship, *The Queen Anne's Revenge*, rests in its watery grave just miles offshore), and plan a trip to The North Carolina Aquarium at Pine Knoll Shores for an up-close look at what lies beneath the seas.


Budget tip: Kick back for a full day of free fun on the beach!

**Where to stay:** The Inlet Inn is right on the waterfront in Beaufort and offers water view rooms with private porches starting at \$174 in summer, which includes a continental breakfast delivered right to your room every morning.

News of the legendary Loch Ness Monster making an appearance in Atlantic Beach on North Carolina's Crystal Coast made waves across the country and, while most likely a whale or eel was spotted, family travelers have all the more reason to visit North Carolina's Crystal Coast to see some amazing wildlife.



The region's most famous animals, Wild Shackleford Horses, descend from the Spanish mustangs brought over by European settlers 400 years ago. These wild horses roam the shores of Shackleford Banks and impress onlookers with their beauty.

Head to Croatan National Forest for some prime birdwatching opportunities. The forest is home to the endangered red-cockaded woodpecker, as well as osprey, great blue herons and *anhingas*.



The Crystal Coast also features a sea turtle sanctuary, situated on Emerald Isle. Every year, between May and November, loggerhead sea turtles come to the beaches to lay their eggs. These endangered animals require protection, especially when they lay their nests.



Look to the sea to spot the Atlantic Bottlenose dolphin, a popular sea creature that makes the most appearances in winter when they come to the area's inland bays. To see the dolphins up close, book an excursion with Crystal Coast Ecotours to enjoy a personalized and guided tour of the barrier islands and potentially spot these graceful creatures.
