## North Carolina Aquarium at Pine Knoll Shores—Pine Knoll Shores, NC

Just five miles from Atlantic Beach on the Outer Banks, the North Carolina Aquarium at Pine Knoll Shores lies amid the Theodore Roosevelt Natural Area. With two nature trails and outdoor adventures, like kayaking and beach walks, the aquarium makes the most of its location. The largest aquarium in North Carolina, Pine Knoll Shores spans 96,000 square feet and contains the state's largest manmade ocean habitat, called Living Shipwreck.
