





Boiling Springs - The picturesque town of renowned fly-fishing, access to the famous Appalachian Trail and the popular Children

Camp Hill - Located on the lively West

Shore, Camp Hill is just two miles from the state capital of Harrisburg. The downtown features great local shops and restaurants. **Carlisle -** The historic, Preserve America town of Carlisle is noted for its restored architecture and tree-lined streets filled with shops, galleries, museums, restaurants and more.

offers small-town charm including mom-and-pop shops, local restaurants and a collection of events. **Newville -** At the crossroads of routes 233, 641



> Cumberland County Biker-Hiker Trail (F-7) Located inside Pine Grove Furnace State Park (see listing in Hiking) Trail entrances at Laurel & Fuller Lakes. Two miles of easy to moderate trails. Bike rentals available at Laurel Lake concessions (seasonal). All roads in the park are open to biking.

Cumberland Valley Rail Trail (CVRT) • 860.0444 & 🕸 (A-7 & D-4) Trail entrances at Newville Trailhead Facility, 23 McFarland St; Oakville Rd, Oakville; Shippensburg Township Park, Britton Rd • cvrtc.org 9.5-mile trail follows the abandoned Cumberland Valley railroad from Shippensburg to Newville. Suitable for walking, running, biking & horseback riding. Also see (G-4) for 1-mile trail end in Carlisle. There are two shared-use trail systems: 38-mile Flat Rock trail system north of Route 30 & 31-mile Michaux trail system south of Route 30. Most trails are difficult to most difficult. Tuscarora State Forest (see listing in Hiking) All state forest roads are open to mountain biking.



Appalachian Trail (see more information under Hiking) Bring binoculars! To the north, the Kittatinny Ridge forests will host scarlet tanagers & indigo buntings, while Eastern bluebirds & American kestrels can be spotted in the rolling farms in the valley to the south. In the forests of South Mountain, cool ravines of hemlock will host winter wrens, & the beautiful wood thrush song can be heard in the deep forest areas. Numerous streams & runs along the A.T. support American woodcocks, belted kingfishers, & Acadian flycatchers.

Big Spring Creek Greenway (see listing in Fishing) Birders have identified 180 species here & birds of all kinds are Children's Lake (see listing in Boating) Watch for the occasional common loon. Bald eagles, osprey, hooded

mergansers & American widgeons have also been spotted. In the

woodlands downstream, watch & listen for a variety of birds including Baltimore orioles, belted kingfishers, & red-eyed vireos. Colonel Denning State Park (see listing in Hiking) Watch & listen for various owl, woodpecker & hawk species, along with numerous songbirds including scarlet tanagers, Eastern towhees, blackburnian warblers, Eastern wood-pewees & wood thrush. Flat Rock trail is excellent for watching fall migration raptors.

Conodoguinet Creek Water Trail (see listing in Boating) Along with a wide variety of ducks & wading birds, the forested buffer adjacent to the creek hosts many species of birds including warblers, wrens, woodpeckers & hawks. Watch for cedar waxwings, goldencrowned kinglets & yellow-bellied sapsuckers. Travel slowly & quietly to optimize your viewing opportunities. Hunters Road & (D-3)

Hunters Rd. Newville 17241 Look for bobolinks, savannahs, vespers & grasshopper sparrows, blue grosbeaks, Northern harriers & possibly even short-eared owls.

**Huntsdale Fish Hatchery** (see listing in Fishing) West of Kings Gap State Park is Enck's Mill Pond & Hidden Pond at Huntsdale Fish Hatchery. Both host migrating & resident waterfowl, but also watch for a variety of hawks, owls & woodpeckers, along with wrens, warblers & other songbirds. More than 150 species have been spotted at Huntsdale. Also watch for turtles & other reptiles. King's Gap Environmental Education Center (see listing in Hiking) The open pines around the center harbor pine warblers & attract other migrating warblers & other songbirds. Areas in & around pine plantation at the foot of the mountain are good for migrant sparrows. Further up the mountain watch for scarlet tanagers, pine & yellow-

rumped warblers, & wood thrush. LeTort Spring Run Nature Trail (see listing in Other Outdoor Recreation) The variety of habitats offers excellent birdwatching. Songbirds such

as common yellowthroats & Carolina wrens, flit among the trees while fishing birds, such as belted kingfishers & great blue herons, hunt the stream. Watch for various sparrow, woodpecker & hawk species. **Opossum Lake** (see listing in Boating) More than 140 species of birds have been spotted in & around this 59-

acre lake & its adjacent habitat of fields & woodlands. Species include Eastern meadowlark, tundra swan, green-winged teal, common loon, common yellowthroat, & blue-headed vireo. Pine Grove Furnace State Park (see listing in Hiking) Laurel Lake is the better of the two lakes for migrant waterfowl.
