Boiling Springs

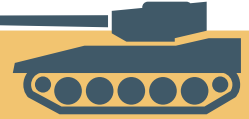
- Explore Children's Lake

Newville

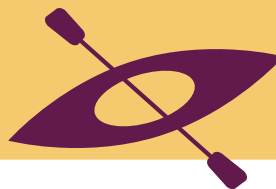
- Enjoy ice cream from Jaymee Lee's Diner
