Children's Lake (see listing in Outdoors) Stopping point for migrating songbirds, as well as year-round resident & migrant waterfowl, including cross-breed ducks & geese. Colonel Denning State Park (see listing in Outdoors) Enjoy a large variety of birds while walking on trails. Flat Rock Trail (see listing in Overlooks) is excellent for watching fall migration raptors.

Huntsdale Fish Hatchery (see listing in Fishing) Hidden pond attracts dabbling ducks, Wood Duck, Black-crowned Night-Heron & Rusty Blackbird. King's Gap Environmental Education Center (see listing in Outdoors) The open pines around the center harbor Pine Warbler & attract other migrating warblers & other songbirds. Areas in & around pine planta-

tion at the foot of the mountain are good for migrant sparrows. Pine Grove Furnace State Park (see listing in Outdoors) Laurel Lake is the better of the two lakes for migrant waterfowl. 
