CARRINGTON PAVILION

Carrington Pavilion is an outdoor amphitheater located on the banks of the Dan River in Danville, VA. With over 1,184 covered seats and 5,000 festival-style seats on the lawn, the venue has served as home to the Danville Harvest Jubilee Concert Series, a multifaceted event with food, live music, entertainment, and family-friendly activities, since 1980. The venue has hosted many nationally-known recording artists, including Blake Shelton, Riley Green, and Cooper Alan, and it continues to welcome music lovers to the region today.
