MAIN STREET

1. 140-150 Main Street – Stevens Tire & Auto: 5,100 square feet of outside sales of food, retail sales pin-striping, vehicle accessories, parts, service, clothing, souvenirs, photos, jewelry, LED's, trailers, RV's, and trinkets. Paid motorcycle parking.
2. 216 Main Street – AMP Street Properties, LLC: Paid parking only.
3. 300-310 Main Street – Boot Hill Saloon: 500 square feet of outside sales of food, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, retail sales jewelry, and Boot Hill logo merchandise. Outside entertainment by live band, acoustic, comedy, karaoke, contests, and jukebox. Religious distribution of literature by Calvary Christian
4. 500 Main Street – Humphreys & Son: 2,231 square feet of outside retail sales of t-shirts, eyewear, patches, and jewelry. Paid motorcycle parking.
5. 504 Main Street – KW Hemp: 250 square feet of outside sales of food. DJ with amplified music.
6. 511 Main Street – Main Street Barbershop: 5,790 square feet of outside retail sales of event merchandise, hats, t-shirts, sweatshirts, and non-alcoholic beverages.
7. 605 Main Street – Ocean Center: Indian Motorcycle display. Recorded music and announcements.
8. 700 Main Street – Full Moon Saloon Daytona: 200 square feet of outside sales of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, retail sales of apparel, accessories and tobacco. Recorded and live entertainment with amplified sound, contests, promotions and inflatables.
9. 705 Main Street – Dirty Harry's Daytona: 820 square feet of outside sales of food, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, retail sales of apparel, accessories and tobacco. Recorded and live entertainment with amplified sound, DJ, contests, and inflatables.
10. 777 Main Street – Biker Clothing Apparel: 4,600 square feet of sales of food, non-alcoholic beverages, retail sales of event merchandise, sunglasses, jewelry, leather, patches, and pins etc. Alcoholic beverages to be sold by South Haven Christian Church Inc.
11. 800 Main Street – Froggy's Saloon: 820 square feet of outside sales of food, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, retail sales of t-shirts, long sleeve shirts, hoodies, hats, stickers, key chains, sunglasses, pins, patches, tank tops, short sleeve shirts, stuffed frogs, shot glasses, and koozies. DJ with amplified music and dancers.
12. 801-811 Main Street – Hot Leathers: 2,400 square feet of retail sales of clothes and motorcycle apparel.
13. 9-25 North Peninsula Drive – AMP Street Properties, LLC: Paid parking only.

14. 12 North Halifax Avenue – Arlid Austgarden/Paul Sousa: Paid parking only.
15. 20 & 24 North Halifax Avenue – Casa Del Sweeney, LLC: Paid parking only.
16. 34 North Halifax Avenue – Volusia County Beach Rentals: Paid parking only.

FAIRVIEW AVENUE

17. 118 East Fairview Avenue – Euro Cycles of Daytona: 2,500 square feet of outside sales of food, motorcycles, motorcycle parts, motorcycle accessories, motorcycle repairs, retail sales of t-shirts, hats, mugs, jackets, pants, helmets, and key chains.

BEACH STREET

18. 290 North Beach Street – Indian Motorcycle Daytona Beach: 17,850 square feet of outside sales of food, non-alcoholic beverages, motorcycles, motorcycle parts/accessories, painting, pin-striping, custom built parts/accessories, performance products/upgrades/accessories, motorcycle engine lubricants, equipment/lift/tools, lighting products/accessories, LED's, audio products/stereos/speakers, motorcycle and leather cleaning products, eyewear, ear protection, clothing/accessories, footwear including leather footwear, leather clothing, leather bags/products/accessories, pins, patches, stitching, tobacco products, jewelry, cutlery, installation and repairs, and motorcycle warranties.
